Location: Throughout the Summer Village of Bondiss

Event Overview:

Kids and families will dress up in their favourite costumes and walk or ride their bikes around the village to trick-or-treat in the sunshine. Participating residents will mark their property with a sign or orange balloons to show they are handing out candy (and/or adult treats). It's a safe, fun, and community-spirited event for all ages!

How it Works:

For Trick-or-Treaters (Families & Kids):

- Wear a costume – this is family orientated, so keep it PG please!
- Walk or bike the community during the event time.
- Visit properties that display a sign or orange balloons at the end of their driveway.
- Collect candy and treats from participating homes.
- Please supervise children at all times and stay off private property unless invited.

For Participating Homes:

- Put out orange balloons, or a sign at the end of your driveway to show you're taking part.
- Set up a table at the end of your driveway to keep the participants from wandering through your property.
- Consider playing music or decorating your yard to add to the fun.
- Be ready to hand out candy to kids and optional "treats for grownups" (e.g., adult beverages) to parents – but:
 - All adult treats must be given out on private property (driveway, front yard, etc.).
 - Do not serve or consume alcohol on roads, sidewalks, or public spaces.
