POLICY





SUMMER VILLAGE OF BONDISS PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT INSPECTION AND MAINTENANCE POLICY

EFFECTIVE DATE: March 18, 2025

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish guidelines for the regular inspection and maintenance of playground equipment within the Summer Village of Bondiss to ensure the safety and well-being of the community.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all public playgrounds owned and maintained by the Summer Village of Bondiss.

POLICY STATEMENT

- 1. Playground equipment shall be inspected and maintained every **two years**, beginning in **2025**.
- 2. Inspections shall assess structural integrity, wear and tear, and compliance with safety standards.
- Any identified hazards or deficiencies shall be documented and addressed promptly to mitigate risks.
- 4. Routine maintenance shall include cleaning, lubrication, tightening of hardware, and repair or replacement of damaged components.
- A record of all inspections and maintenance activities shall be maintained for accountability and future reference.
- 6. The Summer Village of Bondiss shall ensure that inspections and maintenance are conducted by qualified personnel or certified playground inspectors.
- 7. Public notices shall be issued if a playground requires temporary closure for repairs.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- The Municipal Administration shall oversee the implementation of this policy.
- Designated staff or contracted professionals shall conduct inspections and maintenance.
- Council shall review inspection reports and approve necessary repairs or improvements.

REVIEW AND AMENDMENTS

This policy shall be reviewed every five years or as necessary to remain aligned with best practices and regulatory requirements.
