

The Steps: Character to Comics in the Classroom

The Role of SunriseKid Publishing at your school

1. To *Teach* and then have you *Practice* how to use the program site. Both for the teachers and the students
2. To *Meet with Teachers* to discuss how they was to group students and carry out or implement their comic book making projects.
3. To Provide the *usernames/passwords* to the assigned groups of students.
4. To *Assist in the editing* of the books as they are created by the students.
5. To *Publish the class comic book* or *individual comic books* for the students.
6. To *Deliver the published books*, as well as take photos and do interviews with students etc.

Publishing details and estimated costs for both schools and individual students & their families

Whether publishing a class comic book, individual student's comic book or an individual student's fictional or non-fictional story-novel, prices will vary depending on the following criteria:

- How many classrooms and or students participate
- How many times you take advantage of the program during the year.
- Having me assist in the editing process as the books are created (optional step, which I charge \$30 per hour).
- The size and length of the book, and whether you choose a softcover or hardcover. For example, an estimated cost for an individual student wanting their 30 page story published and having chose a softcover (paperback) with it already typed up and illustrated, would cost approx. \$40.
