

Overall Layout Plan











COMMON REGULATION

- SELANGOR INTERNATIONAL RACE 2024 ("SIR2024") (the "Event") is organised by Perbadanan Kemajuan Negeri Selangor (PKNS) ("the Organiser") and managed by **Cyclomotion** ("the Manager") with full support from the Selangor State Government, Polis DiRaja Malaysia ("PDRM"), and Malaysia National Cycling Federation ("MNCF"). These Rules and Regulations ("R&R"), the Waiver, and all the Terms and Conditions ("T&C") for riders can be found at https://selangorrace.com ("Official Website").
- 2. By participating in the Event, a rider, defined as an individual who has entered the event, is deemed to have given written permission to the Organiser for the collection, analysis and compilation of personal information relating to that rider. By completing the official entry form, which includes online registration, the rider explicitly indicates his/her agreement to comply to these R&R.
- 3. The Organiser reserves the right to use any photographs, motion pictures, images, recordings, or other records of the Event and its riders for various commercial advertising and promotional purposes.
- 4. The rider, who has registered to take part in the Event is deemed to have given written permission to the Organiser for the collection, analysis and compilation of personal information relating to that rider. The Organiser may exercise this discretion as they deem fit, including and without any limitation, information for their programmed, planning, data-processing, statistical or risk analysis, research, fundraising, and/or any other purpose related to their functions.
- 5. The rider agrees to:
 - Provide true, accurate, current and complete information about the rider captured in the registration form (the "Registration Data");
 - Maintain the security of the rider's password and identification; and
 - Maintain and promptly update the Registration Data to ensure that it is true, accurate, current and complete.
- 6. The Organiser may contact the rider from time to time by email. Any notice sent to the email address registered with the Organiser shall be deemed to be received by the rider concerned. After registration, there will be no fee refund for any rider who does not in due course take part in SIR2024, for any reason whatsoever. Registration is strictly non-transferrable.
- 7. After registration, there will be no fee refund for riders who do not in due course take part in the Event for any reason whatsoever. Registration is strictly non-transferable.
- 8. There will be no further extensions of any registration periods.
- 9. The Organiser reserves the right to modify or substitute any of these R&R and/or T&C from time to time as it deems fit. If there is ambiguity in any of these provisions, the Organiser shall be the sole entity authorised to provide interpretation, taking into consideration the interests of all affected riders. Any amendments to these R&R and/or T&C will be updated on the Official Website.



- 2. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel the Event without prior notification to riders at any time, in which case the Organiser will endeavor to notify riders before the Event date. If the Event is cancelled, there will be no refund of fees paid and the Organiser shall not be liable for any consequential losses or inconveniences.
- 3. The Organiser reserves the right, at any time and without prior notice to riders, to modify the Event cycling routes as it deems fit for the safety of the riders and / or to mitigate any potential hazards during the Event. In such situations, every effort will be made to inform riders prior to the Event date. The Organiser shall not be liable for any losses or inconveniences resulting from these changes.
- 4. In cases of registration on behalf of any participant, the principal member or the online user account owner bears full responsibility for informing each member of the Event's R&R. Furthermore, they are deemed to have obtained the approval of each member participant to accept the R&R on their behalf. Any member participant who has authorised this online registration by their friend is also deemed to have read and accepted the Event's R&R.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. By registering his / her entry each rider indicates his / her acceptance of the conditions below. To participate in the Event, riders need to adhere to any age requirements that are specified for their respective category.
- 2. Riders must adhere to the following:
 - Equipment and Age Group
 - Participation Categories
 - Type of Event : Race or Endurance
- 3. Participants in the Men & Women categories, must be 16 years old and above as of **31 December 2024**. On Special Request participants under the age of 16 are required to have a Parental/Guardian consent letter sent to the organizer.

Men's Oldtimers (Age51 and above)

Men's Heavyweight (Weight 90kg and above)

- 5. Pro-cyclist, Continental Team, State & National riders are ALLOWED to participate in any of RACE categories stated above.
- 6. The distances and durations listed for all categories (Race and Endurance) are approximate and subject to change at the Organiser's discretion, should circumstances require such adjustments.
- 7. ONLY Road Bikes for both event (Race and Endurance).
- 8. The following bikes are STRICTLY NOT ALLOWED for any category:
 - Bikes with Disc Wheels / Rim Covers;
 - Bikes with Aero or Extension Bars:
 - Bikes with Fixed Wheels with No Brakes; Fixie Bikes;
 - Specialist Time Trial Bikes;
 - Motorized Bikes;
 - Unicycles;
 - Scooters.
- 9. Bikes with Drop Handle Bars and / or Disc Brakes are allowed.
- 10. Tandem bicycles are allowed for visually handicapped riders ONLY, and participants should seek clearance from the Organiser on a case-by-case basis.
- 11. Riders who arrive at the Event with unapproved bikes will regretfully be unable to participate.
- 12. The organiser reserves the right to invite or reject any individual / team from joining this event.
- 13. No maximum number of members for both Race and Endurance team classification.
- 14. To determine the winning teams for team, kindly view under Events Classification section.
- 15. All prize-winning participants must present their original identification documents, such as an Identity Card or Passport, at the result verification counter located beside the Secretariat tent. Participants who fail to verify their identification within 20 minutes may have their results cancelled and replaced by subsequent winners.



- 16. Prize winners are required to report to the prize-giving zone located beside the stage. If a cyclist fails to do so after repeated announcements or within 15 minutes, the Organiser may donate the cash prize money to charity or replace the winner.
- 17. Prizes not claimed within two (2) weeks from the Event date will be forfeited and the Organiser will have the discretion to redistribute or dispose of these proceeds as it sees fit.
- 18. Prizes must be accepted in the form as presented by the Organiser. They are not transferable or exchangeable for cash and are subject to the R&R and / or T&C as determined by the Organiser.
- 19. The winners of all applicable categories will be determined by the "Gun Time". All prize winners or potential prize winners wishing to appeal or dispute results must do so in person and in writing on-site. Appeals must be submitted within 15 minutes of the results being posted on the board at the Event site. To file an appeal, participants must provide an appeal fee of MYR100 in cash and a completed appeal form available at the Secretariat tent at the event site. Whenever possible, appeals should be made before the prize presentation. The Organiser reserves the right to reject any disputes or appeals made after the prize presentation.
- 20. All disputes regarding the results will be decided by the Commissaire Panel and Organiser, and their decision will be final. No further disputes will be entertained thereafter.

RIDE REGULATIONS

- 1. Riders are strictly **NOT ALLOWED** to transfer their ride entries to another party or change ride categories once their registration is confirmed.
- 2. All riders are to start in their allocated pen at the start line.
- 3. For safety reasons, riders who do not start at their respective flag-off time may be disqualified and not allowed onto the course. Timing detection will be used as proof.
- 4. All riders must follow the designated routes and are solely responsible for adhering to the designated route and passing timing points (Check Point).
- 5. Route officials will divert riders who are unlikely to finish the ride within the stipulated duration to designated diversion points along the route. For their safety and to avoid being caught in between live traffic, riders must follow instructions. Failure to do so may result in immediate removal from the route. Finisher's medals will not be issued to riders in this situation. In the competitive rides category, these riders will be recorded as 'Disqualified' or 'DNF' (Did Not Finish) in the official timing.
- 6. During the ride, all riders must adhere to the standard national rules of the road and follow the directions provided by police, traffic management personnel and Event officials.



- 7. Riders MUST NOT:
 - Ride without a protective cycling helmet;
 - Ride dangerously or negligently; or
 - Use MP3 Players, iPods, Walkman's or other mobile music devices while riding.
 - Use handheld cameras or telephones while riding.
- 8. At all times, riders are required to stay behind the safety escort lead vehicles and in front of the safety escort rear vehicles. Always KEEP LEFT of the road.
- 9. Helmets are a mandatory requirement for participation in all ride categories. Rear lights are optional but highly recommended to facilitate good distance judgement while cycling.
- 10. You are **NOT ALLOWED** to ride under someone else's name or bib number under any circumstances. In the event of fraud, the relevant rider will be disqualified and ineligible to win any prize.
- 11. The Event will take place regardless of bad weather and will only be cancelled, re-routed or stopped in extreme circumstances for safety reasons. The final decision on this will rest with the Organiser.
- 12. Child seats on bicycles are not allowed due to safety reasons.
- 13. For the *Men Heavyweight 90kg and Above Category*, the top **fifteen** riders of the category will be weighed by our officials to determine the eligible winners.
- 14. No push-assist allowed by any official or riders, if caught will result in disqualification (DSQ).
- 15. The decision of the panel commissaire is final. Penalty scale are apply.

RIDERS' ENTITLEMENTS

- 1. All riders who successfully complete the ride in their chosen category will be awarded a Finisher's Medal upon the presentation of their Cycling Bib to the respective officials.
- 2. Finisher's Medals are to be collected on Event day located after finish line.
- 3. Participants will be equipped with a timing device. Finishing times will be recorded by the official timing devices and will be posted on the website within 5 working days after the Event's completion.

SAFETY MEASURES

- 1. While the Organiser will take reasonable precautions to ensure riders' safety, participants in the Event do so at their own risk. The Organiser will not be held responsible or liable for any injury or death arising from training for or participating in the Event. Riders are strongly encouraged to consult their medical practitioner before registration and before the Event day.
- 2. The form on the reverse side of the cycling bib must be fully and accurately completed. Riders are required to attach the assigned bib to the lower back of their cycling jersey or t-shirt, the bike plate number under the seat post of their bicycle, and the bib with timing to the front of the bicycle handlebars. Riders not wearing a bib will be asked to leave the route.



- 3. Before the Event, all riders must check and service their bikes to ensure they are roadworthy prior to the start.
- 4. Riders should always be aware of other cyclists around them.
- 5. All Riders are expected to keep to the left-hand side of the road unless overtaking, and must adhere to traffic rules at all times. Overtaking on the lefthand side is dangerous and is NOT ALLOWED.
- 6. Riders are required to call out when passing fellow cyclists.

MEDICAL RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Stationary Medical Support and Mobile Medic will be available throughout the Event. To receive such support, riders MUST wear their cycling bibs.
- 2. Riders who require medical assistance while on the route may seek help from Motor Medic, Ambulance, Motorbike Marshall staff or traffic management personnel.
- 3. Medical personnel reserve the right to remove a rider if he / she is judged to be physically incapable of continuing his / her ride without posing a risk of serious injury to him / herself or others.
- 4. Medical personnel reserve the right to make the final call to send casualties to the nearest and / or recommended hospital.
- 5. The Organiser recommends the following measures to reduce medical risk:
 - Riders should drink plenty of fluids before, during and after their ride.
 - Riders over the age of thirty-five (35) years and who have not engaged in regular exercise in the recent past are strongly encouraged to undergo a medical check-up before the Event.
 - Undertake a proper training regime to prepare for the Event.
 - INSURANCE POLICY
- 6. Riders participating in the Event are advised to practice safe cycling, and they do so at their own risk. Accordingly, the Organiser shall not be liable for any bodily injuries or loss and / or damage to property, whether personal or otherwise, arising in any way.
- 7. The Organiser will not be liable for the actions of riders or other third parties, not employed by the Organiser or acting on its behalf.
- 8. All riders are recommended to have their own personal accident or health insurance.
- 9. In case of serious accident during the race and need for further treatment, the patient will be transported to the nearest hospital. Treatment of minor injuries will be carried out at the Medic Bay.
- 10. Please inform the organiser in case of an accident and need immediate assistance or the patient needs to be sent to the hospital.



FEEDING AND MOBILE ASSISTANCE

- 1. The organiser provides Mobile Feeder and Mechanic Assist services along the race route to assist all the cyclist.
- 2. In case assistance is required, the rider should stop pedaling on the left side of the road and raise their hand to indicate assistance is required.
- 3. The rider is **not allowed** to ask for help while in the big group, he must go back and ensure a safe distance before receiving any help or feeding.
- 4. All feeding must be done behind the commissaire's car on the left side of the road.
- 5. Waste from feeding supplies should be stored or disposed in a designated area or handed over to the nearest race official. If found dumping rubbish by the Commissaire, a fine will be imposed to the riders.
- 6. **NO team support vehicles** are allowed to accompany the race convoy. Should any unauthorised team vehicle found and providing assistance to a rider or team during the race, the rider or team will be disqualified (DSQ) from the race immediately.
- 7. The Race Management / Traffic Control reserves the right to move out any unauthorised vehicles out of the race convoy immediately. Only vehicles with official registration (sticker) are allowed to be in a racing convoy.

CUT-OFF TIME

- 1. Riding Cut-off Time: 6 hours 30 minutes
- 2. Water Station Cut-Off Time:

WS1: KM40.0 | Kuang 09:30am
 WS2: KM66.9 | Fruit Valley 10:30am
 WS3: KM90.5 | Kota Puteri 11:30am
 WS4: KM112.5 | Puncak Alam 12.30pm

(Riders who pass this cut-off time are consider as out of race and not allowed to continue cycling. Average speed +/-25kmh)

- 2. Riders who exceed the cut-off time will be directed to stop cycling and will be required to board the broom lorry. Failing to comply with the instruction, the organiser will not be responsible for the safety of the rider during the ride.
- 3. Participants who are no longer able to pedal may wait/rest at the nearest water station area to be send back to the finishers by Organiser.
- 4. The organiser places a timing vehicle in race convoy for the indicator to the riders on racing time and cut-off time.
- 5. Riders who are behind the timing vehicle with a time gap of more than 20 minutes from the lead group will be considered to have passed the cut-off time of the race. May result as Did Not Finish (DNF).



EVENT CLASSIFICATION

Overall Winner

• The winner is determined by **who reaches the finish line first**. Only **2 winner** of each event (Race and Endurance), male and female. Time recorded base on 'Gun Time' from start to finish.

Category Winner

• The winner is determined **by who reach the finish line first**. Apply to all categories (Race and Endurance)

Sprint & KOM

- The winner is determined based on the fastest individual time record based on the distance set at the location. All participants have the opportunity to win this classification.
- There is a cut off time to attempt the SPRINT & KOM classification.
- Sprint Zone will be closed at 11.00am and KOM Zone at 11.30am

Best Team

- The winner is determined by adding up the fastest times from the riders in the same team cross the finish line. Only best rider is selected in each poll group to contribute to team's winning.
- Poll time group for Race Event MUST consist of 3 rider
 - ✓ 1 Rider from Men U18 or U23 Category
 - ✓ 1 Rider from Men A or Men B Category
 - ✓ 1 Rider from Women Open or Men C Category
- Best time group for Endurance Event MUST consist of 5 rider
 - ✓ At any Category
 - ✓ The winning team's time is calculated by the fifth (5th) fastest team rider to cross the finish line.

WEATHER POLICY

The Event will take place rain or shine, unless the Organiser determines that conditions are too dangerous. This decision will be made prudently either three (3) days before the Event day or on the Event day by the Organiser in consultation with local law enforcement officials and Commissaire Panel. If the Event is cancelled due to inclement weather, there will be no refunds or transfers. In the event of inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances, the Organiser reserves the right to alter, cancel or eliminate any / all portions of the Event.

CONSENT TO THE EVENT

By participating in the Event, I agree to abide by these Rules & Regulations. PKNS and Cyclomotion, the Organiser, reserves the right to modify these Rules & Regulations in any way and at any time, as deemed necessary or appropriate, without materially affecting the terms and conditions of this cycling event. I consent to the use of any photographs, motion pictures, images, recordings, or any other records that may include me, in any record of the Event or for future promotion of the Event.
