Meeting tips

- DO offer to play Devil's Advocate.
- DO listen to all ideas with open ears.
- DON'T shut down or interrupt dissent.

Offer & seek divergent opinions:

- Let's surface a few more options.
- I'd like to re-visit the discussion.
- What might we be missing?
- What's limiting our thinking?
- *Name* has worked on this. Let's get her view.
- What would a solution look like if we had no constraints?



Playing devil's advocate

Constructive Devil's Advocacy	Dysfunctional Devil's Advocacy
DO encourage divergent thinking and generate options	DON'T persuade others to adopt your/one point of view
DO shape and influence the decision process	DON'T veto or dictate the outcome
DO ask lots of novel and probing questions	DON'T tear down proposals or ask "gotcha" questions
DO acknowledge when more data might be helpful	DON'T hoard information that might enable debate

Dare to disagree:

- I think there's a different way to achieve this objective.
- I'd like to offer a different perspective.
- I'm concerned that if we do this, it might result in ...
- I disagree, and would like to offer a different option.
