Friday, October 31st | 7:00 - 8:30 PM.

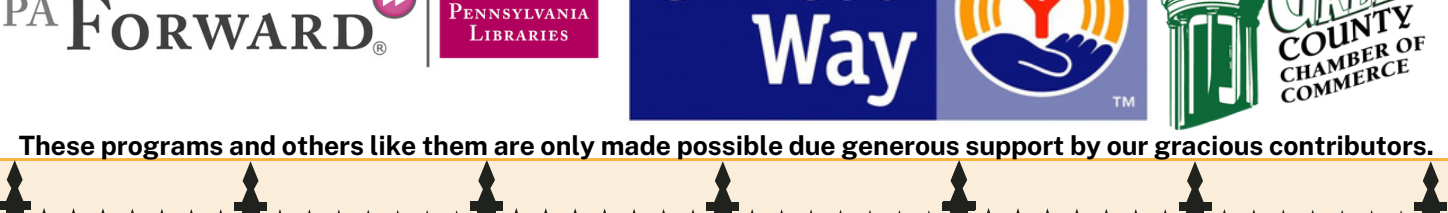

LEGO Build-A-Bag



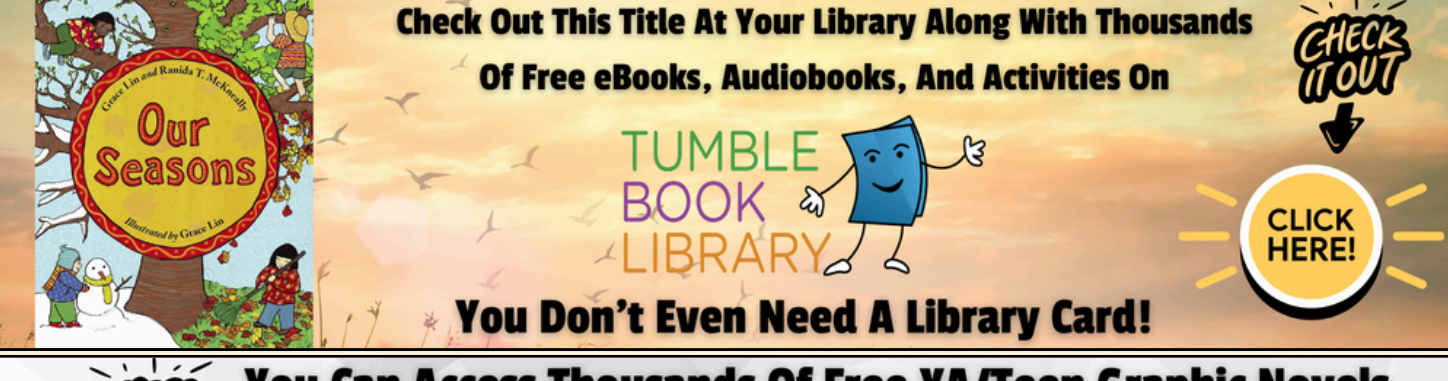
Saturday, October 18th | 10:00 AM - 3:00 PM

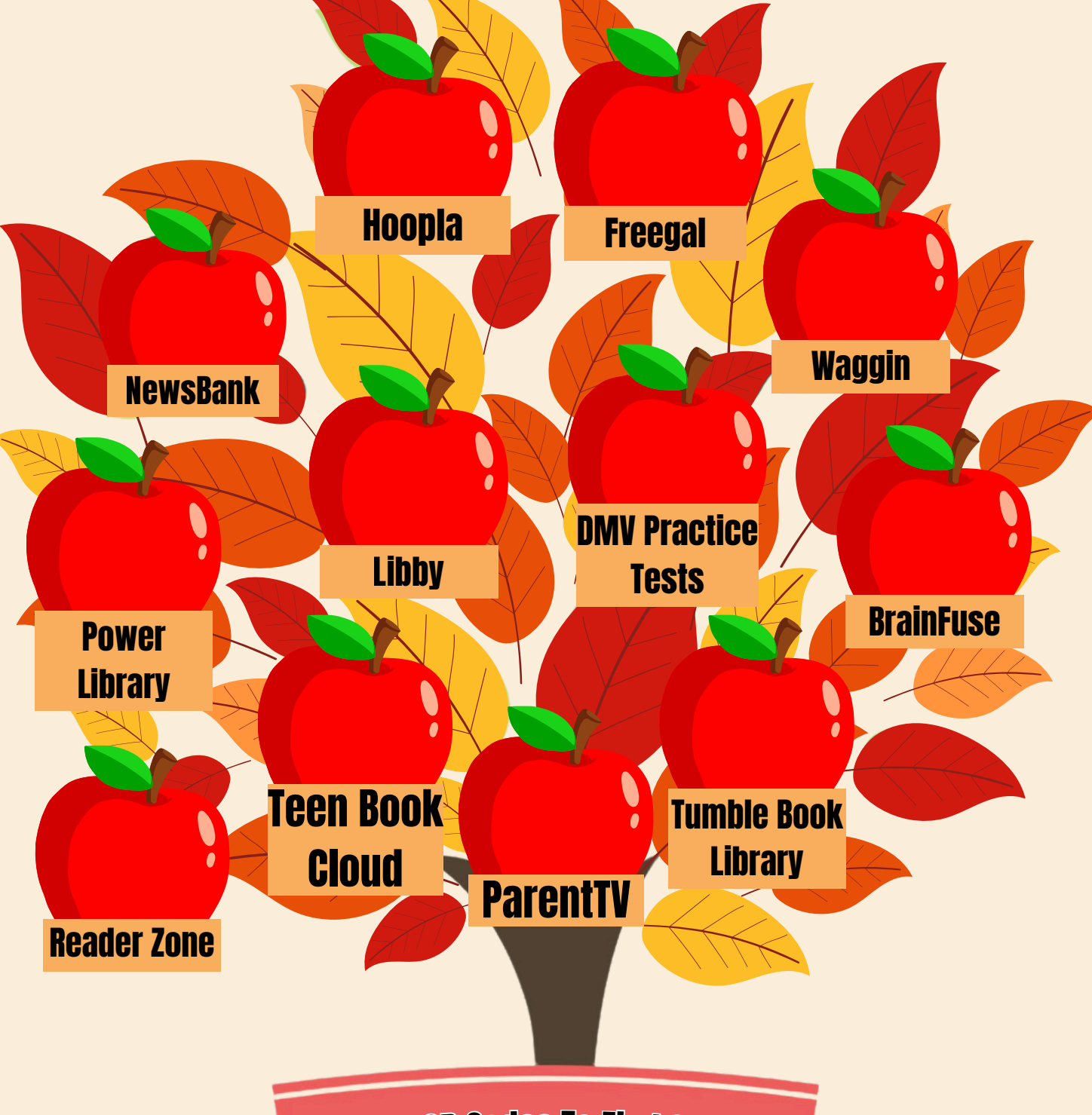
