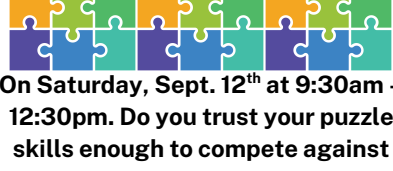

Movie Night



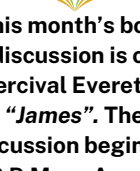

Book Club



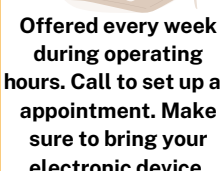

Weight Loss Support Group



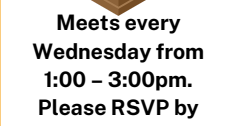

Mahjong Club

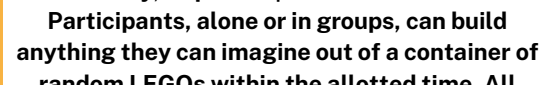

BINGO

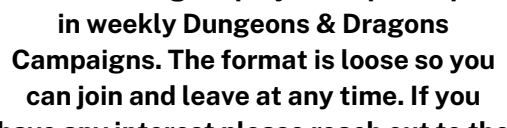

LEGO Build-A-Bag



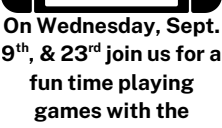

DUNGEONS & DRAGONS



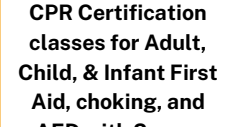
