Board of Ed had no report.

Treasurer's report showed a positive in the offerings and no unexpected expenses have arisen at this time.

Outreach reported that the website is being used each week. 17 donations were made at the last blood drive and the next blood drive is at Bethlehem on Dec. 18.

Jeff reported that the finance committee has had new interest in their work and are so grateful for all their dedicated workers who keep the records each week.

The other half was divided with \$300 going to Edgar Circle of Joy, \$660.41 to Cindy Wrucke, missionary to the Czech Republic, and \$660.41 to Lutheran World Relief Fund Emergency Relief fund. Motion was made, seconded and passed.


The LWML will not meet in December. We will have our regular meeting again in January.






Issues, Etc. is a ten-hour weekly syndicated radio talk show and podcast.
