The Pastor's Message

Every three years, each district of the Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod, meets in convention. During these conventions officers are elected to conduct the business of their particular district by delegates from each member congregation of the district. Every congregation or dual parish is allowed to send one pastoral delegate and one lay delegate to cast their votes for the elections and to make decisions on district business brought to the convention. On June 1st and 2nd, the convention of our North Wisconsin District was held at the Central Wisconsin Convention Center in Rothschild, and Roger Ballerstein and I attended as representatives for Bethlehem – St. John.

This year's convention met under the theme of "Alive," and as every convention does, opened with a Divine Service. The president of our district for the past 12 years, Rev. Dwayne Lueck, presided over the convention proceedings for the final time after announcing his retirement last year. President Lueck has served our district faithfully during his tenure, and was unopposed each time he was re-elected over his last 3 terms. The delegates gave thanks to God for his years of service, and wished him God's continued blessings in his retirement.

The election of a new District President was the first order of business to be conducted by the convention, and the names of 5 candidates were put before the assembly for nomination: Rev. Donald Engebretson (Polar, WI), Rev. David Karolus (Antigo, WI), Rev. Travis Kleinschmidt (Shawano, WI), Rev. Preston Paul (Eleva, WI), and Rev. Timothy Shoup (Bonduel, WI). On the fourth ballot, a majority of the delegates selected Rev. Timothy Shoup from St. Paul Lutheran Church & School in Bonduel to be our new District President.

Pastor Shoup is 64 years old and has been a part of our North Wisconsin District since 1998 when he was first called to St. Paul in Bonduel. He also served at a congregation in Ohio, and at another one in Minnesota. Pastor Shoup has been a Vice-president in our district since 2018, and he has served in various other roles over the years. In 2019, Concordia Publishing House published his book of devotions titled *Praise & Honor: Hymn-Inspired Devotions* which takes 14 different hymns from our hymnal, *Lutheran Service Book*, and provides insightful and rich commentary to help the reader in their Christian life. The hymns are selected by different categories such as "Resisting Temptation," "Baptism," "Confirmation," "Comfort," and "Daily Praise." We give thanks to God for providing our District with a new President, and please remember to keep President Shoup in your prayers as he begins his new calling this month.

Other offices were filled during this year's convention as well. Three vice-presidents were chosen to assist with the district's work. The first Vice-President who represents the central region of the district is Pastor Donald Engebretson (Polar, WI). He has served the past several years as District Secretary. The second Vice-President is Pastor Preston Paul (Eleva, WI) who is re-elected to represent our western region of the district, and the third Vice-President representing the eastern region of the district is Pastor Ryan Fehrmann (Bonduel, WI). The rankings of the vice-presidents simply determine an order of succession should something happen to the District President. Several other positions were elected to serve our district including a new District Secretary (Pastor Travis Kleinschmidt, Shawano, WI) who is responsible for keeping records, examining congregational constitutions, and updating the District constitution as needed.

District conventions also consider and vote on whether or not to adopt resolutions that congregations and other entities bring before it. This year, the convention delegates approved 9 resolutions during their meeting, including one to give thanks to God for the many years of service from President Lueck and his wife, Cheryl. 
