### The Ceremony

Should you choose a civil ceremony, there is the choice of three rooms in the manor house for a maximum of 40 people.

Cadhay can also offer the Granary, the Old Apple Store or the Bothy in the garden for up to 110 people. Should you decide to be married in the garden, you can choose one of our other ceremony rooms for your 'wet weather' back up!



If you wish to be married in church, then Cadhay is an ideal 'home' to be married from, and to return to for your reception.

Please note that for a legal ceremony you will need to book and pay Devon Registrars separately.





### The Reception

For your reception at Cadhay, you have the choice of three options depending upon your guest numbers.

### The House

### The Old Apple Store

A delightful converted barn and paved terrace, which can seat up to 80 people and is available for you to decorate as you wish.

The Granary offers you more options and choices from a quiet space, to a drinks reception.

## Luxury Accommodation.
