Motion – Motion made by K. Fields to approve the meeting Minutes from February 18, 2020. Motion seconded by E. Bair. Motion unanimously approved.

Motion - Motion made by E. Bair to approve the Treasurer's Report as reported for December 31, 2019. Seconded by M. Moreno. Motion unanimously approved.

MANAGEMENT REPORT:

- **Roof Replacement** S. Adler reported that two appraisers are in the final process of selecting an umpire regarding the dispute between the Association and Traveler's Insurance on the amount of the claim.
- <u>Landscape</u> S. Adler received a proposal from Semper Fi for core aeration (\$1,650) and overseeding (\$2,432).

Motion – Motion by K. Fields to approve core aeration and overseeding by Semper Fi at a cost of \$4,082.00. Seconded by E. Bair. Motion unanimously approved.

• <u>1760 Middlebury</u> – S. Adler reported that the homeowner has damage behind the insulation in the garage along the outside wall of the unit.

Motion – Motion by K. Fields to approve the damage repair by Construction Concepts at a cost of \$1,305. Seconded by M. Moreno. Motion unanimously approved.

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- <u>Snow Removal</u> S. Adler will send out bid specifications for snow removal requesting costs for (1) fixed rate with a 2" trigger, (2) fixed rate with a 1" trigger and (c) per push at 2" but if the Board requests a push a 1", the cost would be at the 1-1" rate.
- <u>Proposed Rule Change</u> The Board discussed the proposed rule change to allow electronic voting at annual meetings. This change would not take effect until 120 days after the approval.

Motion – Motion made by E. Bair to approve the rule change to allow electronic voting at annual meetings. Seconded by K. Fields. Motion unanimously approved.

• **FHA Recertification** – S. Adler reported that the Association has been FHA recertified. The new expiration date is 2/19/23.
