This year the Valleyview AG Society is putting on a "Dust Out the Tack Room" Spring Fling Jumping hosted at at the Lazy H Arena outside of Valleyview.

We are also working with CP Alberta with a fundraiser bake sale and Jeopardy class.

Table C Jumping Rounds - faults are penalized and add 4 seconds onto time of round, if riders are doing the same height only their fastest time will count towards the placings. Prizes will be awarded to at least $1^{\text {st }}$ place.
Heights - Trot Poles \& Crossrails (Novice \& Open), $2^{\prime}-2^{\prime} 3,2^{\prime} 3-2^{\prime} 6,2^{\prime} 9-33^{\prime} 3,3^{\prime} 6-3^{\prime} 9$
CP Fundraiser Jeopardy- Jumps have assigned points, Vary in size (crossrails-2'3") and difficulty. 90 seconds to safely jump as many as you can.

Lead Your Spring Lamb - Lead your horse through a trot pole and crossrails course.
Baby Chicks - Any horse or rider competing at its first competition over an inviting cross rails course.

Taste the Rainbow! - A Liberty-type class with a course of very small (< 2') jumps you have to convince your (un-bridled) horse to jump/follow you over a designated course. 4 seconds added for every time the handler must touch the halter! Any kind of treat incentive allowed.

Easter Surprise Hunt - Grooms and riders welcome, the fastest person around a course on their own 2 feet. Group 1 will be ages 6 and under, trot poles \& cross rails, Group 2 is ages 7 and up, 2 ft course. You get to keep your findings!

Bouncing, Hopping Bunnies - Bareback jumper. Crossrails -2'.
Easter Eggies - Trot poles and crossrails course that can be ridden lead line or walk/trot.
Leaping for Gold - 3 bar championship. Winner receives a saddle pad!
