- -1 entry per person, per category
- -Entries may be themed or freestyle by design
- -Project can be ASSISTED by an adult, but MAJORITY of work must be done by the participant
- -Baking Class numbers to submit: 3 per display
- -Entries must be labeled with entrant's first name and age group on bottom of display ( no visible names on top)
- -Classes will be judged by the following: Creativity, originality, visual appeal, skill & technique. In food classes cleanliness, finish, and edibility.

- -1 entry per person, per category
- -Entries may be themed or freestyle by design
- Class B-S3 numbers to submit: Min 3
- -Entries must be labeled with entrant's first name and age group on bottom of display (no visible names on top)
- -Classes will be judged by the following: Creativity, originality, visual appeal, skill & technique. In food classes cleanliness, finish, and edibility.
- -Pies/loafs crust color, texture
- -Photography 4x6 picture: Focus, clarity, lighting, creativity, and impact
- -Sewing workmanship, design/pattern, finishing touches, and overall presentation

**FBA Classes**- Composition, color, technique & skill, creativity, and presentation

**FBP Classes**: Composition, focus, clarity, lighting, and creativity impact

**FBQ, FBT, FBW Classes**: Workmanship, design and pattern, materials used, finishing touches, and overall presentation

**FFA Class**- Creativity, originality, visual appeal, skill & technique

**FFB Class**: Creativity, originality, visual appeal, skill & technique, cleanliness, finish, and edibility

Family Farm Garden Class:

FF-G1: Vegetable display containing: a potato, a carrot, a zucchini and a beet

FF-G2: Largest pumpkin

Family Farm Arts & Crafts Class:

FF-A1: Lego design

Family Farm Baking Class: FF-B1: Cake decorating

FF-B2: Cupcake decorating
