STABLING - Outdoor pens and indoor box stalls are available.

1. Shavings are available @ \$15.00 per bag.
2. A \$25.00 refundable deposit is required for all box stalls. Your deposit will be returned upon inspection of a clean stall. Stalls must be left in good repair and cleaned. Please enclose a separate payment for stall deposit. E-transfer together with your entry fee is accepted and will be refunded in cash.
3. There is a limited number of box stalls. Stalls that have been paid in full will be reserved, first paid, first reserved.
4. Box stalls are \$40.00 for the first night, \$25.00 for additional nights. Outdoor pens are \$20.00/day.
