Rules: In judging the design, usefulness and finish of the articles will be considered as well as workmanship. Only non-professional exhibitors are permitted. Previously entered articles are not permitted to be entered again. All entries must be neat and clean. Where necessary, entry tags are to be attached to items with safety pins, not tape or wires.

### **Sections & Classes**

### Class 1: Floral Arrangements, Flowers & Plants

Rules: All exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor and or family. Bring your own containers, not of monetary or sentimental value. Water will be available. All short stemmed blossoms or blooms should be in covered containers without foliage. Name the variety where possible. Remove all foliage below the water line.

#### 1. Floral Arrangement, Flowers & Plants General

For Junior Exhibitors use same class & number and add age to the tag

### Class 2: Baking & Preserves

Rules: NO commercial fillings or mixes are to be used. Canning should be labeled and dated and not more than 1 year old. Each exhibitor is allowed to enter only one item per section. Please cover all baked exhibits with plastic wrap.

- 1. Baking General
- 2. Preserves General

For Junior Exhibitors use same class & number and add age to the tag

### Class 3: General Arts and Crafts

Rules: Includes painting, drawing, all crafts. Only non-professional exhibitors are permitted.

- 1. Arts and Crafts ages 17+
- 2. Arts and Crafts ages 13 16
- 3. Arts and Crafts ages 7 11
- 4. Arts and Crafts ages 6 and under
- 5. Tie Dye T-Shirt

### Class 4: Photography

Rules: Open to amateur photographers only. Prints should be 4"x6" only and matted on thin card board. Each print must be the work of the exhibitor.

- 1. Photography General ages 17+
- 2. Photography General ages 16 and under
