Heights (Open & Novice) - Trot Poles & Crossrails, 2', 2'3, 2'6, 2'9, 3'

Hunters – Judged rounds over fences where horse is judged for jumping style, canter, and overall impression.

Equitation – Rider is judged on riding ability.

Clear Round Classes – the objective is to jump the course without knocking a rail and under the time allowed set by the course designer.

Match the Clock – the objective is to ride at a steady consistent pace and finish the course as close as possible to optimal time set for the course designer.

Speed Round – All speed rounds are Table C speed where the objective is to ride the course in the fastest time without faults.

Lead Your Pumpkin – Lead your horse in hand through a trot pole and crossrails course.

Little Ghosties – For novice riders (under 10yrs). Trot poles and crossrails course that can be ridden lead line or at a walk/trot.

Trick or Treat! - A Liberty-type class over a crossrails course. The rider has to convince their unbridled horse to follow/jump over a designated course. 4 seconds added for every time the handler must touch the halter! Any kind of treat incentive allowed.

Witch Hunt (Footrace) - Everyone welcome, the fastest person around a course on their own 2 feet. Group 1 will be ages 6 and under, trot poles & cross rails, Group 2 is ages 7 and up, 2ft course. You get to keep your findings!

Through the Pumpkin Patch - Bareback jumper. Crossrails -2'.

Over the Full Moon - 3 bar challenge.
