

Amendment No 2 to Ordinance No 107
ORDINANCE NO. 113

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE USE OF WATER FROM THE WATER WORKS OF THE TOWN OF SUGAR CITY, COLORADO, AND ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING WATER RATES AND PRIVILEGES, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF SAID RULES AND REGULATIONS", PASSED AND ADOPTED ON MAY 23, 1921, BEING ORDINANCE NUMBERED 107 OF SAID TOWN OF SUGAR CITY.

Be It Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Sugar City, Colorado:

Section 1. That Rule 15 of Section 2 of Ordinance Numbered 107, of the town of Sugar City, Colorado, entitled "An Ordinance to Regulate the Use of Water from the Water Works of the town of Sugar City, Colorado, and Establishing Rules and Regulations Governing Water Rates and Privileges, and Prescribing Penalties for the Violation of said Rules and Regulations", be amended so as to read as follows:

Rule 15. No occupant or owner of any building within the corporate limits of the town of Sugar City, into which water is piped from the water-works system of said town, will be permitted to supply water to the occupant or owner of any other building or property within said town, nor will such occupant or owner be allowed to supply water to any other buildings or premises whatsoever within said town, which may be occupied or owned by such water user, except upon the payment of the regular rates as herein prescribed for the class of property upon which said water is being consumed. No occupant or owner of any building within said corporate limits, into which water from the water-works system of said town is piped, shall be permitted to supply water to any other person or persons whomsoever, except the actual occupants of said property, unless application shall first be

made to the proper official of the Water-works Department, and the payment of the regular rates for the use of such water in advance, as in this Ordinance set forth. Any occupant or owner of property within the town of Sugar City who has regularly paid all water rentals due to said town for the use of water from its said water-works system shall be permitted, without further expense or charge, to use from the artesian water system in said town water for domestic use, which water shall be used only upon the premises upon which such water consumer is then paying the regular water rental. The water department agrees to furnish water for a certain specified sum. If, therefore, consumers furnish other people or supply water for animals or for sprinkling, washing vehicles, or for building purposes, or permit it to be taken without the knowledge and consent of the water department, it is a violation of contract and consumers so offending will be required to pay double the price of water so used, and the city reserves the right to shut off the supply for abuses of water privileges. When the water has been turned off for violation of the rules, the water department will withhold it until all dues and penalties have been paid, including the further sum of \$2.00 for turning the water off.

Section 2. That Rule 20 of Section 2 of said Ordinance Numbered 107 be amended so as to read as follows:

Rule 20. Whoever shall, by himself or by anyother person acting under his authority, use or take water from any part of the water-works aforesaid, or from the artesian water system of said town of Sugar City without a license or permit, or without authority from the proper official of said water-works system, or whoever shall hitch to, take out, curb over or remove any fire plug or hydrant, stop cock valve, valve box or any other fixture pertaining to said water works or shall let on or shut off water

into or from any water pipe wherever situated, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction therefor fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00.
