An ordinance creating a Budget with various funds for the Official yea 1923 and 1924.

CEMETERY FUND.

All money from plots sold to be placed in Cemetery Fund
 Approximately \$100.00
 1/2 Mill Levy..... approximately 163.19
 Total.....263.19

WATER WORKS FUND.

All money collected from water rent to be placed in water works fund, approximately.....3200.00
 1/2 mill levy approximately..... 163.19
 3363.19

Water bond and interest, National Sugar Mfg. Co. pipe line rental, Fuel, Gas and Oil, Southern Colorado Power Co. Lights and power for pump house and marshall's residence, and \$40.00 per month on Marshal's salary to be paid out of the water work funds.

SEWER FUND.

All money from County Treasurer to go in respective funds, Districts 1 and 2 for bonds and interest.
 1/2 mill levy approximately.....163.19
 To go into a special fund for cleaning septic tanks and repair lines.

STREET FUND.

All money collected from Dof tax and Poll tax to go into Street fund approximately..... 60.00
 2 1/2 mills levy approximately..... 815.96
 Total..... 875.96

SALARY FUND.

3 mills levy approximately..... 979.15.
 Treasurer, Clerk, Mayor and Councilmen and Health Officer's salaries also balance of Marshall's salary to be paid from salary fund.

CONTINGENT FUND.

All fines collected to go into Contingent fund approximately 20.00
 9 mills levy..... 2937.46
 2957.46

Street lights, Funding Bonds, Interest, Upkeep of Park and Special Police to be paid out of Contingent Fund.

Total budget not including Sewer assessments 8602.46
