

Ordinance No 102.

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF CALIFORNIA AVENUE,
IN THE TOWN OF SUGAR CITY, COLORADO.

BE it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Sugar City, Colorado:

Section 1. That the following described portion of California Avenue in the Town of Sugar City, in the County of Crowley, in the State of Colorado, be, and the same is hereby, vacated as such avenue and street, and the same is hereby discontinued for all public purposes:

Beginning at the intersection of the West side line of California Avenue and the south line of the right-of-way of Missouri Pacific Railroad Company; thence along the said Westside line of California Avenue to the intersection of the North line of the right-of-way of Missouri Pacific Railroad Company and the West side line of California Avenue; thence in a Northeasterly direction along the right-of-way of Missouri Pacific Railroad Company to the intersection of the East side of California Avenue and the North line of the right-of-way of Missouri Pacific Railroad Company; thence South along the East side line of California Avenue to the intersection of the South line of the right-of-way of Missouri Pacific Railroad Company and the East side line of California Avenue; thence in a Southwesterly direction along the right-of-way of Missouri Pacific Railroad Company to the point of beginning.
