

Ordinance No, 108.

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING APRIL FIRST 1922.

BE ir Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Town of Sugar City, Colorado.

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of the revenues of the town of Sugar City for the fiscal year ending April 1st, 1922 the followinh sums estimated to be the arcunts necessary to defray the expenses and liabilities of the Town of Sugar City, Colo., for said year.

For Interest and Principal on refundsbonds	1800.00
For repairs and maintenance Sewer Dasts Nos 1 & 2	200.00
For salary fund	1000.00
For Contingent fund	2000.00
For Water Works maintenance fund	2000.00
For street fund	600.00
For Cemetery fund	100.00
For Interest in funding bonds	880.00
Total	8580.00

Section 2. All revenues earned by the Sugar City water works for the fiscal year shall be credited to the appropriation fund for the maintenance of water works and all salaries and expenses incurred for the maintenance of said water works.

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All moneys received from the sale of cemetery lots shall all be credited to the cemetery fund, and said money shall be used for the improvement of said cemetery.

All moneyv received from poll tax shall be credited to the street fund and said money shall be used for the benifit of the streets os said town.

All monwys received from the special tax levied for paying interest of the water refunding bonds and for the purpose of returing said bonds issue shall be credited to said fund and used for no other purpose.

All moneys received from the assessment on lots for the sewer system shall be credited to the sewer fund to be used for paying interest due on said bonds for said fuscal year and for taking up as many of said bonds as possible.

Passed this twenty first day of March, 1921, A. D. at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Sugar City, Colo., a majority of the whole being present and voting.
