

Ordinance No. 103.

An Ordinance concerning annual appropriations for the Fiscal Year ending April 1st, 1921.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated town of Sugar City, Colorado.

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of the revenues of the Town of Sugar City, for the fiscal year ending April 1st, 1921 the following sums estimated to be the amounts necessary to defray the expenses and liabilities of the Town of Sugar City for said fiscal year.

For interest and principal on issue of refunding bonds	1900.00
For interest and principal on Sewer bonds Dists 1 & 2	1099.00
For salary fund	650.00
For Contingent fund	2000.00
For water works maintenance fund	2100.00
For Street fund	600.00
For Cemetery fund	100.00
For interest on funding bonds	880.00

SECTION 2. All revenues earned by the Sugar City water works for the said fiscal year shall be credited to the appropriation fund for the maintenance of water works and all salaries and expenses incurred for the maintenance of said water works.

All moneys received from the sale of cemetery lots shall be credited to the cemetery fund and said money shall be used for improvement of said cemetery.

All moneys received from poll tax shall be credited to the street fund and said money shall be used for the benefit of the Streets of said town.

All moneys received from the special tax levied for paying interest on the water refunding bonds and for the purpose of retiring said bonds issue shall be credited to said fund and used for no other purpose.

All moneys received from the assessments on lots for the sewer system shall be credited to the sewer fund to be used for paying interest due on said bonds for said fiscal year and for the taking up as many of said bonds as possible.

Passed this 15th day of March, 1920, at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Sugar City, a majority of the whole being present.
