

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A BUDGET FOR THE VARIOUS FUNDS
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING APRIL 1, 1940.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Sugar City:

Section 1. GENERAL FUND
 9½ Mill Levy, Approximately-----\$1412.65
 Franchise Privileges, Fines, Forfeitures & Licenses to be
 placed in the General Fund, Approximately----- 250.00
Total----- 1662.65

City Hall maintenance, Advertising & Publicity, Fire Protection, Care of Poor, Elections & Registrations, Salaries of the Mayor, Trustees and Health Officer, \$55.00 per month on the Marshall's salary, \$10.00 per month on the Clerk & Water Commissioner's salary and \$2.50 per month on the Treasurer's salary to be paid out of the General Fund.

Section 2. STREET FUND
 4¼ Mill Levy, Approximately-----\$ 631.96
 Auto License Fees, Approximately----- 235.00
Total----- 866.96

Maintenance of Streets and Alleys and Street Lighting to be paid out of the Street Fund.

Section 3. SEWER FUND
 ¼ Mill Levy, Approximately-----\$ 37.17

Maintenance of the Sewer System to be paid out of the Sewer Fund.

Section 4. WATER WORKS FUND
 All money to be collected from water rentals and the sale of water in any manner to be placed in the Water Works Fund,
 Approximately-----\$3600.00
 2¼ Mill Levy, Approximately----- 334.60
Total----- 3934.60

Repairs for Water Dep't, Supplies, Water Assessments, Miscellaneous labor on Water System, Electric Power Bills, \$25.00 per month on the Clerk & Water Commissioner's salary, \$15.00 per month on the Marshall's salary, \$2.50 per month on the Treasurer's salary, interest on Water Bonds and one \$1000.00 Water Bond to be paid out of the Water Works Fund.

Section 5. BOND & INTEREST FUND
 8 Mill Levy, Approximately-----\$1189.60

Interest on Sugar City Funding Bonds and one \$1000.00 Bond to be paid out of the Bond & Interest Fund.

Section 6. CONTINGENT FUND
 ½ Mill Levy, Approximately-----\$ 774.34

All other miscellaneous bills not heretofore mentioned to be paid out of the Contingent Fund.
