ORDINANCE NO. 47.

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE AREA WITHIN WHICH SALOONS SHALL BE LOCATED WITHIN THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF SUGAR CITY, PROHIBITING THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS ON CERTAIN DAYS, REGULATING SUCH SALES AT OTHER TIMES, REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF SUGAR CITY:

Section 1: That for the purpose of regulating and controlling the liquor traffic and saloon business within the Incorporated Town of Sugar City and promoting the police control of said town no license shall hereafter be granted to any person to carry on or conduct a saloon or engage in the liquor traffic within one mile beyond the outer boundaries of said town nor within the said town, except in business rooms fronting on ~~Cronk Avenue~~ *Colorado Street* and located between ~~Warner Avenue and Cant Street.~~ *Adams Ave.*

Section 2: No saloon or liquor license shall hereafter be granted to any applicant therefor permitting or authorizing any saloon or liquor business to be conducted in any business room located within the area defined by Section One hereof in which said business room a saloon or liquor business shall not have been conducted during the full period of ten days immediately preceeding the date of said application, unless such application shall be accompanied by a written petition signed by at least three-fourths of the whole number of ~~property owners~~ *near property* who own property fronting on said ~~Cronk Avenue~~ *Colorado Street*

bartered, exchanged or given away, located within the corporate boundaries of the town of Sugar City or within one mile beyond the boundaries, shall be closed and kept closed from 12 o'clock at ~~mid-~~ night until 6 o'clock in the morning of every day in the week except Sunday or the first day of the week, and on Sunday or the first day of the week said places hereinbefore in this section mentioned shall be closed at 12 o'clock ~~mid-~~ night on Saturday night of each and every week and kept closed until 6 o'clock on the following Monday morning of each and every week; that during the time or times herein specified in which said saloons, bars or other places are to be kept closed, no liquors of any kind whatsoever shall be sold, bartered, exchanged, given away or delivered. That the ~~curtains and screens~~ *shades that shall be* used in and ~~about~~ *on the windows of said saloon* said saloons, bars and other places shall during ~~said time or times be so arranged as to render the interior thereof~~ *be placed 5 feet above the sidewalk* plainly visable from without (and no person or persons whmsoever) ~~(other than those connected with the business of carrying on or keeping the said saloon, bar or other place or places aforesaid)~~ shall, during said time or times, be permitted to be or remain in or around the same but all and every such person or persons shall be expelled and put out of the same. Any and every person convicted of violating any provision of this ordinance shall be punished by fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 for each offense or be imprisoned in the town jail of the Incorporated Town of Sugar City for a term of not less than ten nor ~~more~~ than sixty days.
