

ORDINANCE NO. 45.

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING CERTAIN PRIVILEGES TO THE COLORADO TELEPHONE COMPANY, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, IN THE TOWN OF SUGAR CITY, STATE OF COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE TOWN OF SUGAR CITY:

SECTION 1. That from and after the date of the passage of this ordinance, and for the full and complete period of twenty years, The Colorado Telephone Company, its successors and assigns, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Colorado, shall have, and it is hereby granted the right, privilege and license to erect in, upon, across, along, under and upon all streets and alleys of the Town of Sugar City such poles, wires and fixtures, and construct such underground conduits as may be necessary for the operation of a telephone exchange in said Town.

SECTION 2. That the right and privilege is hereby granted to The Colorado Telephone Company, its successors and assigns, ^{and} upon, along or under all streets, ~~xx~~ alleys and public ways, and to all extensions of the same, for the placing of poles, posts, underground conduits, man-holes, cables and wires and other necessary fixtures for maintaining and operating said telephone exchange and lines connected therewith. Providing, however, that no pole or poles or other fixtures shall be placed where the same will interfere with any gas lamp, electric light or water hydrant,

SECTION 3. The privilege, franchise and license hereby granted and the construction of the said telephone lines shall at all times be subject to such police power, reasonable dominion and regulations as the Board of Trustees of said Town may by resolution or ordinance hereafter provide, and the Board of Trustees of said Town reserves to itself the right to require said Telephone Company, at any time, to elevate or lower the wires connected therewith at any place in said town to such height above the surface of the street as it may deem necessary, which right may be exercised by said Board of Trustees by resolution prescribing the height of the lowest wires above the surface of the street in any specified locality.

SECTION 4. The Town of Sugar City shall have the privilege at any time of stringing and maintaining upon the poles of the Telephone Company within the Town limits the wire and pole fixtures necessary for a fire alarm system, such wires to be strung under the supervision of the foreman of the Telephone Company.

SECTION 5. The said Telephone Company shall, before it enters upon the enjoyment of the franchise hereingranted, execute and deliver to the Town of Sugar City a bond in the penal sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000), with good and sufficient surety, to be approved by the Board of Trustees, on condition that it will hold the Town of Sugar City harmless from any damage occasioned by the granting of this franchise, or from any damage occasioned by negligence or want of care on the part of said Company, in the construction or maintenance of its telephone lines.
