AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE RECORDER OF
THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF SUGAR CITY AND AMENDING CERTAIN ORDINANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INCORPORATED
TOWN OF SUGAR CITY:

Section 1: Section 3 of Ordinance Number 11 of the
incorporated town of Sugar City, the same being an ordinance entitled
"Clerk", passed June 25th, 1900, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. The Recorder when acting and performing the
duties of Clerk shall receive as his compensation the sum of \$100.00
per annum, payable semi-annually.

Section 2: Section 8 of Ordinance Number 9, the same being
an ordinance entitled "Town Treasurer", passed June 25th, 1900, is
hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 8: The Town Treasurer shall receive as compensation
for his services the sum of \$100.00 per annum payable semi-
annually out of the Town Treasury.
