

ORDINANCE NO 97.

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR, ENDING APRIL 1ST, 1919.

Be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Town of Sugar City, Colorado:

Section No.1. That there is hereby appropriated out of the revenues of the Town of Sugar City, for the fiscal year ending April 1st, 1919, the following sums estimated to be the amounts necessary to defray the expenses and liabilities of the Town of Sugar City for the said fiscal year:

For interest and principal on issue of Refunding Bonds	1950.00
For interest and principal on Sewer Bonds Dists 1&2	500.00
For Salry fund	600.00
For Contingent Fund	2063.00
For water works XXXXXXXXXX Maintenance fund	2000.00
For Street fund	500.00
For Cemetery fund	50.00
For Outstanding Warrants	337.00
Total	8000.00

Section 2. All revenues earned by the Sugar City water works for the said fiscal year shall be credited to the appropriation fund for the maintenance of water works and all salaries and expenses incurred for the maintenance of said water works,

All moneys received from the sale of cemetery lots shall be credited to the cemetery fund and said money shall be used for the improvement of said cemetery.

All moneys received from poll tax shall be credited to the street fund and said money shall be used for the benefit of the streets of said town.

All moneys received from the special tax levied for the paying interest on the water refunding bonds and for the purpose of retiring said bond issue shall be credited to said fund and used for no other purpose.

All moneys received from assessments on lots for the sewer systems shall be credited to the sewer funds to be used for paying interest due on said bonds for said fiscal year and for the taking up of as many of said bonds as possible.

Passed this 18th, day of March, A.D. 1918, at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Sugar City, a majority of the whole being present.
