

ORDINANCE NO 98.

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
ENDING APRIL FIRST 1920.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Town of
Sugar City, Colorado.

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of the revenues of
the Town of Sugar City, for the fiscal year ending April 1st, 1920,
the following sums estimated to be the amounts necessary to defray
the expenses and liabilities of the Town of Sugar City for the said
fiscal year;

For interest and principal on issue of refunding Bonds	1900.00
For interest and principal on Sewer Bonds Dists 1&2	1099.00
For Salary Fund	650.00
For contingent Fund	2000.00
For Water works maintenance Fund	2100.00
For Cemetery Fund	100.00
For Street Fund	600.00
For Outstanding Warrants	675.00
Totals	9124.00

Section 2. All revenues earned by the Sugar City water works for
the said fiscal year shall be credited to the appropriation fund
for the maintenance of water works and all salaries and expenses
incurred for the maintenance of said water works.

All moneys received from the sale of cemetery lots shall be cred-
ited to the cemetery fund and said money shall be used for the
improvement of said cemetery.

All moneys received from poll tax shall be credited to the street
fund and said money shall be used for the benefit of the streets
of said town.

All moneys received from the special tax levied for paying interest
on the water refunding bonds and for the purpose of retiring said
bonds issue shall be credited to said fund and used for no other
purpose.

All moneys received from assessments on lots for the sewer system
shall be credited to the sewer funds to be used for paying interest
due on said bonds for said fiscal year and for the taking up of
as many of said bonds as possible.

Passed this twelfth day of May A. D. ~~1919~~ 1919, at a regular meeting
of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Sugar City, Colorado. A
majority of the whole being present.
