

ORDINANCE NUMBER 93.

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR, ENDING APRIL 1ST, 1917.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF SUGAR CITY:

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of the revenues of the Town of Sugar City, for the fiscal year ending April 1st, 1917, the following sums estimated to be the amounts necessary to defray the expenses and liabilities of the Town of Sugar City for the said fiscal year.

For salary fund.....	\$900.00
For contingent fund.....	2500.00
For Waterworks maintenance fund..	2200.00
For street fund.....	200.00 400.00
For cemetery fund.....	100.00
For interest on bonds.....	1002.50
For interest and principal on sewer bonds.	456.88
	total, 7559.38

Section 2. All revenues earned by the Sugar City Waterworks for the said fiscal year shall be credited to the appropriation fund for the maintenance of water works and all salaries and expenses incurred for the maintenance of said waterworks.

All moneys received from the sale of lots in the cemetery shall be credited to the cemetery fund and said money shall be used for the improvement of said cemetery.

All moneys received from the poll tax shall be credited to the street fund, and said money shall be used for the benefit of the streets of said town.

All moneys received from assessments on lots for the sewer system shall be credited to the sewer fund, to be used for paying interest due on bonds for said fiscal year and for taking up as many of said bonds ^{as possible} of the denomination of five hundred dollars each.
