

Ordinance No. 99

AN ORDINANCE
CONCERNING SIDEWALKS, CURBS AND GUTTERS
AND ESTABLISHING THE LAWFUL GRADES OF THE
INCORPORATED TOWN OF
SUGAR CITY, COLORADO.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of
the Incorporated Town of Sugar City:

Section 1. The grades of streets shall follow
a direct line between the points for which elevations
are hereby established.

Section 2. The elevations hereby established shall
be understood to mean the number of feet and decimal
part of a foot above sea level.

Section 3. The elevation at ADAMS STREET on the
property line of the Missouri Pacific Railroad and
Colorado Street shall come to the Top of the Rail -
at the time this walk and curb are constructed.

Section 4. The elevation on COLORADO STREET and
WASHINGTON STREET shall be as follows:

On the property and curb line at the

North East corner shall be	4314.29
South East " " "	4313.92
North West " " "	4313.94
South West " " "	4314.21

Section 5. The elevation on ~~COLORADO STREET~~ and
~~DENVER STREET~~ shall be as follows:

At the South East corner	4310.89

" " North East corner	4311.96

Section 6. The elevation on COLORADO STREET and at THIRD
BUFFALO STREET shall be as follows:

At the South East corner	4306.94

Section 7. The elevation on COLORADO STREET and
BALTIMORE STREET shall be as follows:

At the South East corner	4300.66

Section 8. The grades in other sections of town shall
be extended by the Town Engineer by order of the Board
of Trustees.

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Section 9. All gutter shall be 9 inches in depth next to the curb, thence sloping 36 inches toward the center of the roadway. The curb shall be 6 inches in thickness, and shall be 10 feet from the property line on Colorado Ave., and shall be 10 feet from the property line on all other streets in residential part of town.

Section 10. Whenever the Board of Trustees shall order the construction, renewal, or repair of any Curbing or Gutter, the Town Marshal or Street Commissioner shall immediately serve a written or printed, or partly written or partly printed notice upon the owner of each lot or part of lots where the proposed Curbing or Gutter is to be constructed, renewed or repaired as the case may be. The owner of such lot or lots to commence work of construction, renewal or repair of such Curbing or Gutter within five (5) days after notice is served upon him or her by the Town Marshal or Street Commissioner. In case the owner of any lot or part of lot cannot be found in town, should such owner have an agent, such notice shall be served on said agent, and in case of no such agent, notice shall be posted upon the premises at least ten (10) days before the time fixed for the commencement of the work, and if the Post Office address is known of such owner to the officer who shall post said notice, a copy thereof shall be deposited in the Post Office to such owner at such address, with the postage thereon prepaid.

Section 11. In case of neglect or failure on the part of any such owner to construct, renew or repair any such Curbing or Gutter in accordance with such notice within the time therein specified, the same shall be done by the Town of Sugar City, and the expense thereof shall be charged to the owner of the lot or lots abutting on the street where such Curbing or Gutter shall be constructed. The said charge shall be made and the assessment thereof determined in such manner as may be prescribed in Section 13 of the ordinance.

Section 12. If any person or persons shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance in the construction, renewal or repair of any Curbing or Gutter, or shall interfere with or obstruct any of the employees of the Town of Sugar City, or any contractor under contract with the Town of Sugar City, engaged in laying any Curbing or Gutter, he shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction shall be fined not ~~more than one hundred (\$100.)~~ less than five (5) dollars nor more than one hundred (\$100.) dollars.

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Section 13. The Board of Trustees of the Town of Sugar City after receipt of the Town Marshal or Street Commissioner's report, shall by an order assess the expense of the lots or part of lots and improvements thereon describer therein, such order may be in the following form.

(Ordered) that the several sums set opposite the following described lots or part of lots, and improvements thereon, respectively to wit. Lot _____ Block _____ Amount \$ _____ the same is hereby assessed thereon to defray the expense of said Curbing or Gutters constructed by the Town Marshal or Street Commissioner in pursuance of an order passed _____ 19 _____ and that a warrant issued for the collection of such assessment returnable in thirty days from the date thereof. It is further ordered that upon return of such warrant, if any part of such assessment be not collected, The Board of Trustees by their Town Attorney, shall apply to the County Court of Crowley County by action for Judgement against the owner of the lot or part of lots for the improvements made thereon, upon which assessment remains unpaid for the amount of such unpaid assessment and costs, after publishing such intended application in a news paper published in the Town of Sugar City for thirty days.

Section 14. Warrants shall be issued by the Town Clerk and signed by the Mayor, in the collection of such warrants the Town Treasurer is hereby vested with full powers, duties and liabilities in the collection of the same. All moneys collected by him shall be deposited in the Treasury and it shall be the duty of the Treasurer to keep a Curbing and Gutter account, crediting it with all moneys received by him on account of Curbing or Gutter, and charging it with all moneys drawn upon the same.

Passed this 21 day of July 1919 at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of The Town of Sugar City, a majority of the whole number of Trustees being present.
