




New Coaches/Women's Football Coaching Network


We have created a Women's Football Coaches Network in St Neots, aiming to get 10 new coaches qualified and leading the development of the girl's game at SNTYFC. This is to create a sustainable long-term model for women's football in the region:

Coach & Player Development Pathway



We are looking at getting a pathway for them all being Level2/UEFA C qualified by the end of the year, with new girls' teams (x3 - minimum) for next season. We are planning to run Wildcats, just turn up and play sessions for girls, from April onwards (adverts with the details will be out shortly).






Facilities At The Common

Lots going on in the background, which has held up the development of The Common, but we can now finally get going on it. Based on all the discussions, we've scaled things back slightly and will also make it easier to fund and deliver.

Finalising the design and getting approvals (HDC and SNCRP) quickly will be key to it being successful, as can't apply for funding until then:



Items to Consider:

- -The flow of traffic in and out of the site
- -Grass protectors (prevent ground damage and rutting)
- -Gate positions / New gates
- -New car park surface and drainage (inc. clearing and maximising the space around the existing container location)

Patrick our head coach will be leading the effort to go through the actions listed above. If you can help in any way possible, then get in touch with him please.

Partnership with Eaton Socon Football Club

The committees of both St Neots Town Youth FC and Eaton Socon FC have agreed to work together. ESFC are looking to improve their facilities and will provide a pathway for SNTYFC players into adult football (male and female). This partnership is already helping with the development of the girl's game and as a club we are very excited we will now have a pathway for our players into adult football.
