INAPPROPRIATE ATTIRE:

- · Anything that is branded
- Short dresses and skirts
- Shorts
- T-shirts

MEN

- Dark trousers
- · No denim pants or overalls
- · Long or short sleeve shirts
- Suspenders

EXCEPTIONS MAY APPLY

- · Safety and specific work conditions are required alternate attire will be considered
- Certain "areas" have different dress codes to reflect their station.

Sawmill: Bradshaw overalls, red shirt and cap Train Operators: Engineers cap, long pants or overalls
