

Complaints Procedure

Any abuse of the code of conduct or child protection policy by a coach, player or parent must be reported to the Athenry Association Football Club Committee immediately and/or to the club Child Safety Officer where appropriate.

When writing your complaint, keep the following in mind:

- If possible, type the letter, or write it clearly and neatly
- Try to keep the message short, clear and to the point
- Clearly set any history of your case: the date of the event and area of concern, who you spoke to if relevant and what the problem is.
- Give a clear description of the events
- Say what you want them to do to resolve your complaint
- Attach copies of any relevant documentation if applicable (keep the originals yourself)

A complaint will be dealt with by any of the following; Athenry Association Football Club Committee Athenry Association Football Club Committee and Club Child Safety Officer Athenry Association Football Club Disciplinary Committee and Club Child Safety Officer
