From the Pastor's Pen

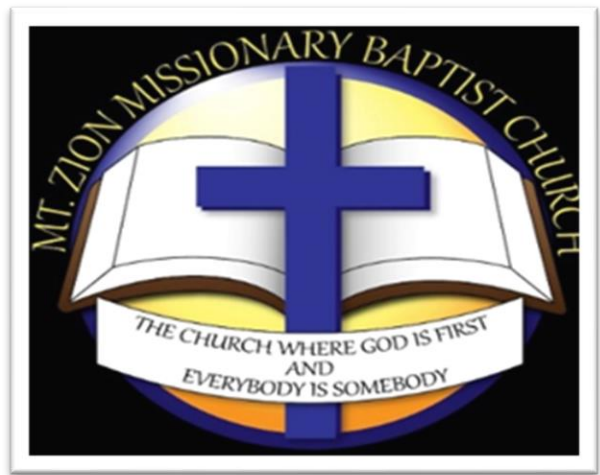


Greetings, Mt. Zion Church Family!
