- I. Chairman **Brian Haldane** called the meeting to order at 6:32 p.m.

- II. **Approval of Minutes.** **Brian Haldane** presented February 9, 2026, meeting minutes. **Donald Hogan** made a motion to approve February 9, 2026, minutes provided in the packet. **Jim Murray** seconded the motion. There were no objections, and the motion passed unanimously.

III. Financial Report.
