SIGNING IN AND SIGNING OUT

Why do you need to sign in and sign out?

This form is located across from the caretaker's residence next to the 550 yd range.

We need to know ...

1. Who is on the property.
2. Which range(s) you are on.
3. That you no longer are on the range or property.
4. That the property is clear of members and guests at closing.

Each individual shooting must sign in. No one else may sign in for you and you may not sign in for someone else. Failing to properly sign in creates an unnecessary liability for the club. Please help avoid legal issues.

ISSUE ON THE RANGE

The Range Officer has noted the use of armor piercing ammunition on the 185 yd range. This is a MAJOR violation of club rules.
