Spring is upon us, eventually; and with the warmer weather, it usually brings more people outside. Please remember courtesy with each other. We are all members who enjoy UNSC, and all enthusiastic about shooting.

Friendly reminder. The rimfire range is not yet open to firearm use. We had an incident earlier this year where person(s) unknown set targets on one of the archery bales for target practice. Don't be that person.

Please do not use targets that are larger than the backer boards. If targets extend below the backer board, this will result in undesirable ricochets. If a target is placed close to the edge of a target stand, the target stand sustains damage.

In addition to the notes about shooting up the 50-yard range, remember there are a number of "please don't be that shooter" items at the sign in booth. These are all items found on the club ranges, and all demonstrate the destruction that happens when we don't take into account the where/what/how we are shooting.

Included in that is, with the exception of the movable stands on the 50-yard range, that all ranges have static distance target frames and positions. They are in place to do all we can to ensure that shots impact a berm. Please do not remove those stands and post taller ones, as this causes skipping which goes who knows where. The 550-yard range is most susceptible to this, but this is to be considered at all locations.

Practicing safe shooting allows us to continue to return and have fun again "eyes and ears"; and let's have some fun.

The 4-H Youth have been hard at work this year getting ready to shoot the 4-H State Competition on May 16-18. Registration just opened up, but we hope to have about 100 competitors ages 11-18 years old competing in Archery, Shotgun, .22 Rifle, .22 Pistol, Air Rifle, Air Pistol, and Muzzle loading.

We will be setting up on May 15th-16th. Competition will start on Friday night, continue all day on Saturday, and end Sunday morning. Keep an eye on the calendar for when ranges are open this weekend. The 185-yard range will be open all weekend long for members and their guests.

With so many youths, UNSC will be a busy place. I encourage you to come and check out what the youth are learning and watch them compete. I will be in the Club House to answer questions and run the competition. It is impressive to see what these youth can do! The I4–I8 year-old participants are competing with others from around the State to secure their spots to be able to Shoot for the Washington State team in June 2026 in Grand Island, Nebraska.

We have 3 youth going to Nebraska this coming June 2025—Spencer in Air Rifle, Grant in Recurve Archery, and Hannah as one of our WA State 4-H Shooting Sports Ambassadors.

LEGISLATIVE BILLS

The links will take you to the Washington State Legislative page where you can read the details of the bill, see the current statis, and contact your legislators.

BILL HB 1132 Enhancing public safety by limiting bulk purchases and transfers of firearms and ammunition.

BILL HB 1152 Enhancing public safety by establishing secure storage requirements for firearms in vehicles and residences.

BILL HB 1163 Enhancing requirements relating to the purchase, transfer, and possession fo firearms.

BILL HB 1386 Imposing a new tax on firearms, firearm parts, and ammunition.

BILL HB1504 Enhancing public safety by requiring financial responsibility to purchase or possess a firearm or operate a firearm range. The bill would require firearm range operators to carry a minimum of \$1 million in general liability insurance and gun owners to carry at lease \$25,000 in coverage per incident of accidental discharge

BILL HB5140 Enhancing requirements relating to purchase, transfer, and possession of firearms.

BILL HB5098 Restricting the possession of weapons on the premises of state or local public buildings, parks or playground facilities where children are likely to be present, and county fairs and county fair facilities.

BILL HB5099 Protecting the public from gun violence by establishing additional requirements for the business operations of licensed firearms dealers.
