WHAT IS HAPPENING AT THE CLUB

MEMBERSHIP ANNUAL RENEWAL WAS DUE OCTOBER 1, 2025

At this point in time, you should have received your "26" year sticker in the mail for each adult member. Lifetime members and youth members do not need a yearly sticker. You will continue using the same badge and keycard. Simply attach the year sticker, so we can easily identify those who have renewed.

If you **have renewed** and have not received the sticker, please reach out so we can rectify this.

If you **still need to renew**, the renewal form is available at the club or on the website. This form can be returned to the club via snail mail, dropped in the lock box, or emailed directly to Debra. Your keycard has been deactivated, and you will not have access to the club property until you have paid the annual membership fee and late fee.

Because you did not renew by November 1, 2025, there is a \$25 late fee added to your annual dues.

If not paid by December 1, 2025, there will be a \$50 late fee added to your annual dues.

If not paid by January 1, 2026, there will be a \$75 late fee added to your annual dues.

If not paid by January 31, 2026, you will be required to start off as a new member paying the initiation fee and completing all of the requirements of new membership.

If you are **not renewing**, please let us know. You can return your keycard to the club. If you have any questions, please contact Debra.

Wildlife on the Range

Before shooting, check to see that the range is clear. Wildlife can enter the range at any moment. A cease fire will be in effect whenever wildlife is on the range.

Damage to the Steel Targets

For those who are shooting armor piercing rounds and causing massive damage to our steel targets, when you are caught, you will be swiftly thrown out of the club and possibly charged with Malicious Mischief 3rd Degree. All calibers of armor piercing rounds are prohibited, which includes green tip 5.56.

YELLOW SAFETY LINE ON THE RANGES

We will be implementing a yellow safety line on the 50-, 100-, 185-, 550- and 600-yard ranges. When members are down range and the sign is out, all other members will remain behind the line until the down range members return and remove the sign.

HELP KEEP THE RANGES READY FOR THE NEXT MEMBER

Please remove your targets when you are done. This has become a problem on the 185-yard range.

LIFETIME MEMBERS

Only those Lifetime members that keep in contact with the club have received the new badge and keycard.

If you lose your keycard, you will need to pay the \$25 replacement fee.
