A NOTE FROM THE RANGE OFFICER

When you bring a guest, remember you are responsible for your guests from the point that you enter the gate with them to the time they leave with you.

Your guest must sign themselves in. You cannot sign them in as that is a federal offense. Guests must also pay the guest fee. Remember to place your names on the guest fee envelope.

We are still having issues with individuals shooting 12 feet in front of the firing line on the 25-yard range. There is NO firing in front of the firing line.

For those members that have not been out here in a long time, please review the range rules boards to make sure that you have not forgotten anything.

We have noted the use of armor piercing ammunition on the 185 yd range. This is a MAJOR violation of club rules.

If you do not follow the rules, your membership is on the line.

WHAT IS HAPPENING AT THE CLUB

GATE UPDATE

Our new gate is in. When you enter, please type # plus the current gate code. Our new gate panel requires 5 numbers/characters, so the # sign will serve as the first number/character. You may also type a "0" plus the current gate code.

MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL

Membership renewals fees are due October 1, 2023.

If you send me the renewal form early, I will hand deliver your new badge and key card for the gate. The first opportunity to receive them will be at our Annual Membership Meeting with other meeting times at the club to be determined. The form can be located on the website, at the club, or with the August Letter Update.

SIGNING IN AND SIGNING OUT

Why do you need to sign in and sign out?

This form is located across from the caretaker's residence next to the 550 yd range.

We need to know ...

Who is on the property.

Which range(s) you are on.

That you no longer are on the range or property.

That the property is clear of members and guests at closing.

Each individual shooting must sign in. No one else may sign in for you and you may not sign in for someone else. Failing to properly sign in creates an unnecessary liability for the club. Please help avoid legal issues.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS Is there a membership limit? Yes, this was voted in at the September Membership limit?

- ⇒ **Is there a membership limit?** Yes, this was voted in at the September Membership Meeting. We have a limit of 2000 voting members.
- ⇒ **Can I bring a guest to the club?** Yes, remember they must remain with you at all times. Please make sure you have them sign in and pay the guest fee. They should join the club after their second guest visit. On all ranges if all benches are in use, non-member/guests must yield their spot to members.
- ⇒ **How do I get a new badge?** Contact Debra. You will need to pay the \$10 replacement fee. Your replacement badge can be mailed to you or can be left at the club for pickup.
- ⇒ **Can I add someone to my membership?** Yes, you will need to pay the difference to upgrade your membership. Contact Debra.
- ⇒ Can my 18-year-old have their own membership? Yes, when a Junior member turns 18, they can have their own membership. They will need to pay only the annual renewal fee. They will not have to pay the initiation fee. They will need to go through the orientation just like all new members.
- ⇒ **Are we accepting new members?** Yes, we are. Please have friends and family complete the application on the website.
- ⇒ **Can I bring my own steel to shoot at?** Personal steel will need to be approved. If you already have approval, you will be contacted regarding the renewal of your approval.
- ⇒ **Can I give my guests the gate code to get in?** NO, this is not allowed. Please meet your guests prior to entering or walk over and put in the gate code when they arrive.
- ⇒ **Can I bring my kids when I come to shoot?** Yes, if they are not members, they will be considered a guest. Please keep them within close proximity to an adult at all times. Safety First!
