

The procedure for a JR member who has turned 18 to get an Adult Membership

You have 2 options if you wish to continue to obtain an adult membership.

Option #1

The new adult member can take the place of a current 2nd adult on a family membership. The current 2nd adult can then be a guest and pay the guest fee if they come to the range and shoot. (\$10 each time) You will complete the Change of Membership form for this situation.

Option #2

The new adult member can get their own individual membership. They will NOT have to pay the initiation fee if they become a member within a year from the time that they were a JR member on an active membership. They will only need to pay the annual membership fee of \$85 each year. You will complete the New Membership form for this situation.

Either way, the new adult member will need to go to an Orientation to learn all the rules and regulations of the club. A background check will also need to be completed on them. (They will need to provide a Washington State ID for this to be completed.)

When you can complete the form, please note on it "JR member to Adult membership." Please include their current membership number. This will change as they will have a number below 2,000.
