Manx Powerlifting is a British Powerlifting affiliation formed in January 2022. We are the only association on the Island sanctioned by British Powerlifting with two club locations – Revolution in Castletown and Fusion Barbell in Douglas.

Since the formation of Manx Powerlifting we have developed a substantial membership base, with ages ranging from 14 to 70 plus! We have successfully ran eight competitions locally and have sent teams of athletes to UK and International Championships with some wonderful results for the athletes, with many medals making their way back to the Island..







2023

Highlights

2023 was a highly successful year for Manx Powerlifting. We held two competitions on Island and had the opportunity to attend various competitions off Island. Here are two of our highlights:



British Sub-Junior/Junior Championships in Solihull

During April 2023, Teagan Lindsay represented Manx Powerlifting as her first ever Sub-Junior British Championships at the age of 16. Teagan took first place as British Champion in the 52kg Sub-Junior class, bringing home a gold medal.



Home Nations in Belfast

In November 2023 Manx Powerlifting made our debut at the Home Nations held in Belfast. A team of 11 competitors took to the platform against teams from England, Northern Ireland, Scotland & Scotland & Wales, with 9 of the 11 Manx lifters competing off Island for the first time! We look forward to taking a team again in December 2024 to compete in Glasgow.

2024

Highlights

Throughout 2024 we have built upon the successes of previous years. Manx Powerlifting held three local competitions and had a fantastic number of Manx athletes qualifying & competing at various British Championships including the British Sub-Juniors / Juniors, the British Masters and British Universities and Colleges Sport(BUCS).

In addition, Manx Powerlifting took a team of 11 to the Commonwealth

Championships in South Africa and are heading to Glasgow for the Home

Nations during December.



British Master Championships, Belfast

In June 2024, Lisa Grant, our head coach, represented Manx Powerlifting at the British Masters Championships. Lisa took first place as the British Champion in the 76kg Masters I class, bringing home a gold medal and an incredible new British Deadlift record of 190.5kg.



Commonwealth Championships, South Africa

In October we sent our second Commonwealth
Team to compete in South Africa. Eleven
competitors with ages ranging from 15 to 51 took
to the international platform, some for the
first time, returning with an impressive 21 medals
across all categories.
