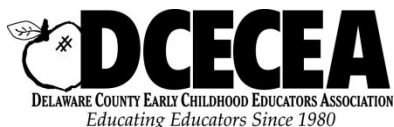

A. MAKING STORYTIME MORE FUN

Attendees will have a lot of fun while participating in an interactive story. They will then take part in a group discussion of how to make picture books more interactive.

B. SPEECH AND LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT: What's typical? What are "red flags?" How can I navigate the referral process?

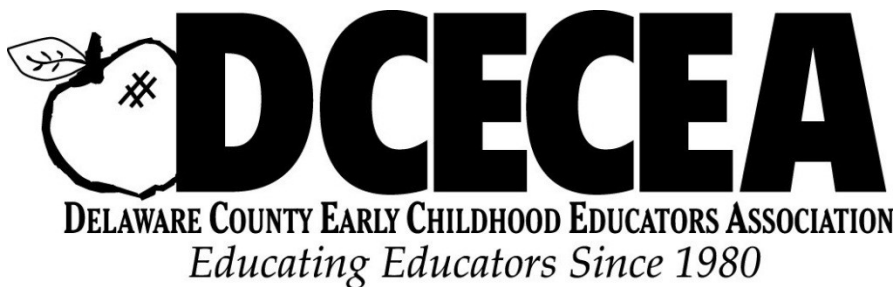
