Pastor's Message

I would like to thank all of you who have already made a contribution to the 2021 Diocesan Development Drive (DDD).

The DDD annual drive is essential for funding and supporting ministries such as these (but not limited to):

- Training our Seminarians, the future priests of our Diocese. Anthony Shumway, our current seminarian, is presently receiving support from the DDD.
- Ongoing training for priests, the formation of permanent deacons (Deacon Joaquin), and formation of Lay Ecclesial Ministers (which St. Martin de Porres hopes to engage in).
- Support of our poorest parishes and missions in Utah.
- Charity outreach to the poor and most vulnerable of our society (remember that some of us serve at the St. Vincent de Paul Dining Hall and other services).

Every year our parish receives an assessment for our portion and our share. This year our assessment is \$29,100. We have already raised \$10,249 payments, leaving \$18,851. If even a third of our approximately 305 registered families gave to the DDD, we would reach the goal with a donation of \$186 or \$15.55 per month.

Mensaje del pastor

Me gustaría agradecerles a todos ustedes que ya han hecho una contribución a la Campaña de Desarrollo Diocesano 2021 (DDD).

La campaña anual de DDD es esencial para financiar y apoyar ministerios como estos (pero no limitado a):

- Formar a nuestros seminaristas, futuros sacerdotes de nuestra Diócesis. Anthony Shumway, nuestro seminarista actual, está recibiendo actualmente apoyo de la DDD.
- Formación continua para sacerdotes, formación de diáconos permanentes (Diácono Joaquín) y formación de ministros eclesiales laicos (en la que San Martín de Porres espera participar).
- Apoyo a nuestras parroquias y misiones más pobres en Utah.
- Alcance de caridad a los pobres y más vulnerables de nuestra sociedad (recuerde que algunos de nosotros servimos en el Comedor San Vicente de Paul y otros servicios).
