



Bible Reading Plan: Trust the Process

Overview:

This 3-day devotional helps believers shift their focus from results to faithfulness. It explores what Scripture says about showing up daily, working diligently, and trusting God with the outcome.

◆ Day 1: Focus on Today

Key Verse:

“Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.”

— Matthew 6:34 (NIV)

Devotional Thought:

Jesus reminds us to stay rooted in the present. When we worry about tomorrow, we miss what God wants to do today. Trusting the process begins by trusting that today's obedience is enough. God doesn't ask us to carry the weight of the future—just to walk faithfully today.

Reflection:

- What distractions are pulling you away from what God is calling you to do today?
- How can you live more intentionally in the moment?

Prayer:

Lord, help me to slow down and trust You with today. Give me the strength to focus on the now and leave tomorrow in Your hands. Amen.

Notes:

◆ Day 2: Faithfulness in the Small Things

Key Verse:

“Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much...”
— Luke 16:10 (NIV)

Devotional Thought:

God doesn’t reward flashy beginnings—He honors consistent, faithful effort. Big breakthroughs often come from small steps taken over time. Every prayer, every act of obedience, and every quiet moment of service matters to God.

Reflection:

- Are you being faithful with the “little things” in your life right now?
- What’s one small area where you can be more diligent this week?

Prayer:

Lord, help me to honor You in the small things. Teach me to be faithful even when no one else is watching. I trust that You see and reward every step of obedience. Amen.

Notes:

◆ Day 3: Leave the Outcome to God

Key Verse:

“Commit your work to the Lord, and your plans will be established.”
— Proverbs 16:3 (ESV)

“Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.”
— Galatians 6:9 (NIV)

Devotional Thought:

We can't control outcomes, but we can control our attitude and effort. God calls us to sow faithfully and trust Him with the results. Some seasons will feel slow or unseen, but God promises a harvest in His timing. Don't give up—He's working, even when you don't see it.

Reflection:

- Have you been discouraged by a lack of visible results?
- How can you commit your work to God and release the outcome?

Prayer:

God, I surrender the results of my work to You. Help me to remain faithful, even when progress feels slow. I trust that You are shaping something bigger than I can see. Amen.
