


THE NEED: FLORIDA ABORTION STATISTICS

- FL has the highest rate of "unwanted" pregnancies.
- Nearly half (48%) of all pregnancies in the state of Florida are considered "unwanted" or "wanted later."
- Nearly half (43%) of those tragically end in abortion.

THE RESPONSE: WALKING WITH MOMS

- Pregnant and parenting moms in need are in our parishes and our neighborhoods, but in desperation, they are turning to other places for help.
- Moms in need are often best reached at the local level. With over 100 parishes in the Archdiocese of Miami, the Church is uniquely positioned to encourage a collaboration of resources at the local level and to increase awareness of help available to mothers and families in need.
- Each parish is best able to identify the local pregnancy help resources that are currently available and to identify potential gaps that need to be addressed.
- Walking with Moms provides a wonderful opportunity to assess, expand, and communicate resources to pregnant moms and families in need.

The goal of the **Year of Service** is focused on providing real, tangible support to pregnant women in need.

Part of the vision for this initiative is to move the conversation from what sometimes seems like a partisan divide into pastoral unity. Partisan messages can prevent women in need from hearing the most important message of the Year of Service:

that the Church is there for them and desires to support them and walk with them during this challenging time.





HOW DO I RUN A SUCCESSFUL BABY BOTTLE CAMPAIGN?



- Connect with your pastor to plan event dates.
- Determine how many baby bottles you will need (50-60% of parish bulletins).
- Contact your pregnancy help center at least 2 weeks in advance to schedule pick up of bottles and educational materials.
- Place a bulletin announcement in your parish bulletin and post flyers announcing the start and end dates.
- Recruit volunteers to hand out bottles at all doors on opening weekend, and to collect filled bottles on last weekend, at all masses.
- Arrange a date/time to drop-off filled baby bottles at your pregnancy help center to prepare for deposit. At least 2 3 people should do this for safety & security purposes.


