- With great openness and courage, we need to question how widespread is the **culture of life** today among individual Christians, families, groups and communities in our Dioceses.
- With equal clarity and determination we must identify the steps we are called to take in order to serve life in all its truth.

USCCB DATA

- We know the challenges can be immense for women in difficult pregnancies, especially women in poverty.
- According to 2014 statistics from abortion providers, women who chose abortion were poor, young, and unmarried
 - (75% were low income, 60% were in their 20's, and 86% were unmarried).
- They came from all cultures and backgrounds (39% were white, 28% were black, 25% were Hispanic, and 6% were Asian or a Pacific Islander).
- And, many of the women who turned to abortion reported a religious affiliation,
 - including a staggering 24% who identified themselves as Catholic (17% were mainline Protestant, 13% were evangelical Protestant, and 8% identified with some other religion).







- The 25th anniversary year of Evangelium Vitae provides a wonderful opportunity to assess, expand, and communicate resources to pregnant moms and families in need.






CLIENTS BY AGE




