We realize that our success is due to all of the dedicated and loyal Funland employees who have worked over the last 60+ years. We want you to know that when you work with our family you are not just another employee but part of our family. Several generations of Funland family members are actively involved in the daily operation of the park so we get to know our employees on a personal level since we work side by side all summer! Many employers are only interested in how many hours you will work or how many shifts your can cover but we want this to be a well rounded experience where you also make friends, grow and create lasting memories.

Throughout the summer our family offers opportunities to interact with your co-workers outside of work. We offer pizza every week after our employee meetings, multiple games tournaments throughout the summer, a movie night, Skeeball/bumper car nights, Employee BBQ, employee breakfast, Employee Appreciation Day, Labor Day Raffle and more. At the end of the summer we hope that you not only worked hard and made great money but that your time at Funland was more than just a job.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Game Attendant

- Operate our 16 amusement games
- Operate the Jungle of Fun, Food Cart, Haunted Mansion Photo Stand and more
- Work with children and the public every day
- Give out prizes to customers that win one of our games and share the excitement with them!
- Work in a fun atmosphere on the boardwalk all summer making memories to last a lifetime

As a game attendant your primary responsibility is to operate our 16 amusement games and the Jungle of Fun in a safe and efficient manner. You will rotate on a daily basis between different games so that you have more and fun! Most days you will work two different games and sometimes more. Since our entire staff rotates each day you get to know all 150 + employees, and it is a great opportunity to make lasting friendships. Teamwork is the key to our success and is the cornerstone to being a good Funland employee.

As a game attendant, you will be trained how to operate each game efficiently and effectively. We will send you out to your assigned game with money in a game bag. You are responsible for that money plus all of the money you collect while at the game. You celebrate the excitement of a win with each customer and provide them with the appropriate stuffed animal or prize. Speed and efficiency are the most important parts of the game attendant position as we want to allow as many customers to play as possible. We provide individual skill games, group competitive games and chance games. While 90% of your job requires you to operate games, we do have some other opportunities if you show interest. We have a food cart, Haunted Mansion photo stand, souvenir area and a ticket booth where you can also work. If you have an interest in those areas and have done a nice job in the games position, we try offer those areas to work as well.

COMPENSATION

- End of season performance bonus worth up to \$1.00 for every hour worked during the summer in addition to your \$13.00 per hour.
- Wages increases over the last three weeks of the summer totaling \$2.00.

- Payday is every Friday.

BASE WAGE

As a Funland employee you will be paid **\$12.00 per hour.** Most game attendants work 4/5 days a week and 25-35 hours per week.

WAGE INCREASES

During the last three weeks of the summer, we increase the hourly wage to reward those employees that stay until the end of our season. Starting Friday, August 19th, wages increase \$.50 to \$13.50 per hr. Friday, August 25th, wages increase another \$.50 to \$14.00 per hr. Friday, September 1st, wages increase another \$1.00 to \$15.00 per hr through the last day of our season which is Sunday, September 10th, 2023. That is a \$2.00 increase over three weeks!

\$1.00 SEASONAL BONUS

Funland also offers an end of season performance based bonus. You can earn up to an additional \$1.00 for every hour worked during the summer. With many employees working 300-400 hours during the summer, it would be equivalent to almost two more paychecks on your last day! Your end of season bonus is tied to the Duration of Work Agreement form you would complete. If you stay for the time you commit to on that form, you are eligible for the bonus. You are then evaluated on your performance. Last summer the average bonus was \$.87 out of a \$1.00! Three examples of total summer earnings can be found in the chart to the left for general reference. Funland has the opportunity to offer you both exceptional pay and lots of hours in a fun job.

HOURS & SHIFTS

Game Attendant

- You never work before 10am or after 7pm.
 (June 1st-Labor Day 9pm end time)
- Funland will work with each employee to determine the best number of days/hours to work each week.
- Funland offers two main shifts and you alternate between starting at 10am and 1pm.
- As a 14/15 year old employee, you have specific limitations while working which are listed on the work permit you must complete.

As a Funland employee, we will work with you to determine the proper work life balance. Funland expects game attendants to work an average of 30 hours per week over 5 days once school is finished. There are two main shifts that game attendants are scheduled. The first shift is 10am-5pm (shift A) and the second is 1pm-7pm (shift B). Each has a half hour break for either lunch or dinner and employees are scheduled a mix of both shifts. Most game attendants take two days off each week, and we like to set them for the entire summer if possible.

SHIFT A 10pm-5pm (30 min lunch break) SHIFT B 1pm-7pm (30 minute dinner break)

Using the example work schedule above, someone would work 29.5 hours in a week. It is common for the game attendant position to be filled by someone who has never had a job before. We want all of our employees to enjoy their job, so we take extra care to make your first work experience a positive one. If for some reason you are overwhelmed by the hours, we are willing to work with you. It is sometimes hard to find the right balance at first, so we encourage new employees to say something if needed.

HOURS & SHIFTS

Below we have listed all of the possible shifts that you might be scheduled in the park. As you can see, there are lots of opportunities to mix and match shifts to get the perfect number of hours.

Below are all the restrictions 14/15 years old employees follow.

Minors 14-15 years of age shall not work:

- Before 7am or after 7pm except from June 1st through Labor Day when it is extended until 9pm.
- More than 4 hours per day on a school day
- More than 8 hours per day on non school days
- More than 18 hours in any week when school is in session for 5 days
- More than 6 days in any week
- More than 40 hours per week when school is not in session
- More than 5 hours continuously without a non-work period of at least 30 minutes

As a Funland employee we expect three main things from our employees.

SAFETY - COURTESY - HUSTLE

Safety is our most important responsibility and is the most important part of your job. Traditionally, this required following all safety protocols listed in the employee handbook and now also includes following all COVID-19 procedures. Our customers come to the park to have fun and smile. Our employees must be happy, helpful and ready to go above and beyond for the children and adults visiting the park. If you like to smile and watch children smile, then Funland is the place for you. We are very busy at Funland, so it is important to be able to work in a fast paced environment. We want to accommodate the needs of as many customers as possible and our employees are the key. If you are ready to work hard, smile, make great friends then you should consider working with our family.

2023 CALENDAR

- Funland opens for the 2023 season on Saturday, May 13th 2023. (Mother's Day weekend)
- Funland will only be open weekends until Friday, June 2nd, 2023 when we open every day.
- Funland's last day for the 2023 season will be Sunday, September 10th, 2023.

There are three weekends of operation before the park opens everyday in early June. We consider the first two weekends training weekends and employees are expected to attend. The third weekend, Memorial Day Weekend is our busiest weekend of the summer and attendance is required. If hired, you will confirm your availability for those weekends on a form we call the Pre-Season Planner*. This form significantly reduces questions and allows you to inform Funland of your specific availability over those weekends.

Funland asks all employees to indicate time off for the summer on a form called the Duration of Work Agreement*. On this form you indicate your full time start date (4 or 5 days a week), vacations, scheduled time off and your planned last day of work for the summer. This form helps Funland plan for the summer and it also ties into your seasonal bonus eligibility.

Before making your decision to work at Funland, be advised that most of your time as well as your best effort will be expected. Funland is very busy each summer and we need as much help as possible from the moment we open until the last day of the season. While Funland will remain as flexible as possible with time off, Funland is a seasonal business and we must keep a full staff to operate the park safely and efficiently throughout the entire season.

*Completion of the Pre-Season Planner and the Duration of Work Agreement does not constitute an employment agreement. These forms allow us to plan on availability for scheduling only. Employment at Funland is at-will. An at-will employment relationship can be terminated at any time, with or without reason or notice by either the employer or the employee.
