FAMILY STATEMENT & COVID COMMITMENT

- We hope that all of our employees feel like part of our Funland family when they work with us. We will make all decisions based on what is best for the Funland family as a whole.

Funland looked much different during the summer of 2020 than any of our previous 58 summers. Still, we found a way to open safely and offer our employees a fun and rewarding experience. As we move into 2021 our family is committed to the continued safe operation of Funland for our guests and all of our employees.

As this summer approaches, we do not know exactly how COVID-19 will impact our operation. Will things be back to “normal”?

***Certainly not.* Will we try to safely move towards a new normal?**

***Absolutely!* Our family believes there are ways to do just that. As we approach this summer, requirements from the state of Delaware will guide our plan as it did in 2020. Right now it is too early to make daily operational plans. If we find ourselves facing many of the same challenges that we did last summer, we will likely operate under the reservations only model of 2020. If the COVID-19 situation improves, it may be possible to offer a hybrid plan. For example, reservations in the early part of the day and some form of open access later in the day with capacity limits. Will we be able to return to using green ride tickets this summer? We are still not sure about this, but eventually we would like to return to that time-tested model.**

Although we continue to wait on some details, others have been set and are listed below. Please review the information provided to learn more about the opportunity to work at Funland.

JOB

DESCRIPTION

Game Attendant

- Operate 16 amusement games
- Operate the Jungle of Fun (currently closed for COVID), Food Cart, Haunted Mansion Photo Stand and more
- In 2020 we also added the position of Gate Attendant for our reservation model.
- Give out prizes to customers that win one of our games
- Work outside at the beach all summer making memories to last a lifetime
- We understand that this is a first job for most game attendants and we want to make sure it is a positive experience.

As a game attendant your primary responsibility is to operate our 16 amusement games and the Jungle of Fun in a safe and efficient manner. You will be given training on how to operate each game and will rotate on a daily basis between games so that you have more fun! Most days you will work two different games and sometimes more. Since our entire staff rotates you will also get to know all 100+ employees and it is a great way to make new friendships. Teamwork is the key to our success and is the cornerstone to being a good Funland employee.

When you are assigned to a game we will send you out with a game bag containing money. You are responsible for that money plus all the money you collect while at your game. When customers win you celebrate the excitement with them and provide them with the appropriate stuffed animal or prize. Speed and efficiency are some of the most important traits we hope to see in a game attendant. In addition to the game attendant role, we also offer a variety of other opportunities at Funland for employees under the age of 16. These include positions as a gate attendant, food cart attendant, Haunted Mansion Photo Stand operator, souvenir area and our ticket booth when we sell ride tickets again. The gate attendant position is only available if we continue to operate with reservations. We will rotate you through all of these positions as needed in addition to the game attendant role.

There are approximately 15 game attendants each summer and most

COMPENSATION

Ride Operator & Game Attendant

- \$9.25 hourly base wage
- End of season performance bonus worth up to \$1.00 for every hour worked during the summer
- Wages increases over the last three weeks of the summer totaling \$2.00
- Pay day is every week on Friday

Summer Earning Examples

As a Funland employee you will be paid \$9.25 per hour. During the last three weeks of the summer we increase the hourly wage to reward those employees that stay until the end of our season. Starting Friday, August 20th, wages increase \$.50 to \$9.75. Friday, August 27th, wages increase another \$.50 to \$10.25. Friday, September 3rd, wages increase another \$1.00 to \$11.25 per hour through the last day of our season which is Sunday, September 12th, 2021. That is a \$2.00 increase over three weeks! Funland also offers an end of season performance based bonus. You can earn up to an additional \$1.00 for every hour worked during the summer. With many employees working 250-300 hours during the summer it would be equivalent to almost two more paychecks! Your end of season bonus is tied to the Duration of Work Agreement form you would complete upon hire. If you stay for the time you commit to on that form you are eligible for the bonus. You are then evaluated on your performance. Last summer the average bonus was \$.87 out of a \$1.00! 🥰

Looking at the potential for summer earnings you can reference the chart to the left as examples. We also offer other employee perks while working which include: free rides, free employee parking, reduced prize costs, pizza nights, bumper car nights, tournaments with prizes and more. Compensation is very important but don't overlook the experience as well!

HOURS & SHIFTS

Ride Operator & Game Attendant

- The typical game attendant works 25-30 hours per week when school is not in session
- Most game attendants work 5 days a week with two set days off but we are flexible with how many days a week you work.
- We are committed to providing you with consistent hours each week, a fun work environment and a memorable summer experience.
- We realize that working as a game attendant also means that this is your first job ever. We will work with you to find the right balance.

As a Funland employee we will work with you to find the right balance of hours. While Funland will remain as flexible as possible, Funland is a seasonal business, and we must keep a full staff to operate the park safely and efficiently. Our family values hard work, dedication to our customers and honoring the work commitment you make to Funland. Funland realizes that you will have vacations and time off during the summer.

We ask that you indicate these events ahead of time when known so we can plan accordingly. As we look to return to a more normal schedule for the summer of 2021 we commit to providing you with consistent hours during the middle of the summer. As we get closer to the start of the season we will provide our employees with more details on the shifts that will be available and the hours of operation each day for the park.

Funland is open weekends in May starting with Mothers Day Weekend. We need as much help as possible and request employees work at least two weekends in May in addition to Memorial Day Weekend. We ask that you balance work around your school schedule until school is out for the summer and you can start full time. This also applies to the end of the season when you return to school and the park is still in operation.

Your Funland interview is a great opportunity to tell us about your summer plans, hours and how we can work together to find the proper work life balance.
