

JOB DESCRIPTION

- **Ride Operator & Game Attendant**
- Operate 17 amusement rides
- Operate 20 amusement games
- Operate the Jungle of Fun, Food Cart, Haunted Mansion Photo Stand and more
- Work with children and the public every day in a customer service position
- Give out prizes to customers that win one of our games
- Work outside at the beach all summer making memories to last a lifetime

As a ride operator & game attendant your primary responsibility is to operate amusement rides and games in a safe and efficient manner. In this position you will be trained to operate the kiddie rides, big rides and all the amusement games in the park. You will rotate on a daily basis between rides and games so that you have more fun! You work with different staff members so you make lots of friends. Teamwork is the key to our success and is a cornerstone to being a good Funlander.

As a ride operator you will receive detailed training on how to safely operate each amusement ride. Safety of our customers is the most important part of your job. Ride operators collect tickets from our customers, both children and adults before loading them on a ride. After following our safety standards, ride operators start each ride and pay attention for possible rider needs. After each ride they help the customers exit and then start the process again.

As a game attendant your primary responsibility is to collect money for each game and to give out prizes to those people that win. Speed and efficiency is the most important part of the game attendant position as we want to let as many customers play as possible. There is nothing better than watching the excitement of a customer that has won a stuffed animal! Being a smiley, friendly and attentive employee is important no matter which area you are working.









COMPENSATION

Ride Operator & Game Attendant

- \$10.00 hourly base wage
- End of season performance bonus worth up to \$1.00 for every hour worked during the summer. That could be the equivalent of two paychecks!
- Wages increases totaling \$2.00 occur over the last three weeks of the summer totaling \$2.00. Pay day is every week on Friday

As a Funland employee you will be paid \$10.00 per hour. Employees work an average of 40-45 hours each week with a potential for even more hours at the beginning and end of each season. We try hard to accommodate the hours you are trying to meet whether it it part time or full time.

During the last three weeks of the summer we increase the hourly wage to reward those employees that stay until the end of our season. Starting Friday, August 21st, wages increase \$.50 to \$10.50. Friday, August 28th, wages increase another \$.50 to \$11.00. Friday, September 4th, wages increase another \$1.00 to \$12.00 per hour through the last day of our season which is Sunday, September 13th, 2020. That is a \$2.00 increase over three weeks which can make a big difference.

Funland offers an end of season performance based bonus. You can earn up to an <u>additional</u> \$1.00 for every hour worked during the summer. With many employees working 600-700 hours over the season it would be equivalent to almost two more paychecks! Your bonus is tied to a form called a Duration of Work Agreement. If you stay for the time you commit to on the form you become eligible for the bonus. Once eligible, you are then evaluated on your performance for your seasonal bonus.

Looking at the potential for summer earnings you can reference the chart to the left. I used the average bonus from 2019 to help show what you might expect from a full season of employment.

HOURS & SHIFTS

Ride Operator & Game Attendant

- Average employees work 40-45 hours per week but we can work with employees to accommodate the nee for more or less hours
- Employees have the opportunity to work 6 days a week with one day off per week if they want to maximize hours
- Funland will work with part time availability for employee or two full days off per week
- Funland offers two main shifts and you alternate between starting at 1pm or 5pm
- You never work before 10am
- Funland does not have a set closing time so you generally finish between 10:45pm until just after midnight on a holiday based on business levels

Most Funland employees work either five or six days a week depending on how many hours you are interested in. You get to pick your days off each week to accommodate time off needs. We will also work with employees that are only looking for part time work but we prefer to employ more full time staff. Below is a typical work week for someone who works six days a week. During the main part of the summer, Funland opens its games at 10am each day and the rides will open at 1pm. You will occasionally be scheduled a 10am-1pm shift on the same day you work a B shift or 5pm start.

SHIFT A

1pm-5:30pm - Dinner Break - 6:30pm-close

(there are several variations of the 1pm start time)

SHIFT B

5pm-close

In the example listed above for a normal week you would work 45 hours. Funland works very hard to accommodate the hourly needs of all our employees. Please let Funland know how many hours you would ideally like to work and if you are looking for full or part time employment during the summer.

SHIFT A 1 pm start with variations listed below

1pm-5pm, 7pm-close 1pm-5:30pm, 7pm-close 1pm-5:30pm, 6:30pm-close 1pm-5pm, 6:30pm-close 1pm-7pm, 7:30pm-10:30pm

• working 1pm-7pm includes a 30 minute unpaid dinner break from 5pm-5:30pm

SHIFT B 5pm-close

When you work a 5pm-close shift you are scheduled to work 5pm-7pm at one game or ride and then we move you to another game or ride 7pm-close.

Employees that are schedule to work 5pm-close or 7-close receive a 30 minute unpaid break between 7:30pm-10:30pm each night.

Understanding the shift possibilities and how an employees is scheduled can be confusing. This is something that we go over in detail during an interview to make sure all questions are answered

Funland opens for the 2020 season on Saturday, May 9th 2020

Funland is only open weekends until Friday, May 29th when the park opens everyday

Funland's last day for the 2020 season will be Sunday, September 13th 2020

The 2020 season will run from Mother's Day Weekend (5/9-5/10) until the weekend after Labor Day Weekend (9/12-9/13). Since Funland is only open two weekends in May before Memorial Day Weekend, we are asking employees to work both weekends and Memorial Day Weekend. Even if you are only able to work part of the second weekend, it is very important for staffing the park.

Opening weekend, Mother's Day Weekend (5/19-5/10) is our first training weekend. The next weekend (5/15-5/17) is our second training weekend. If hired you must attend at least one training weekend and Memorial Day Weekend. If you are able to work both training weekends it would be greatly appreciated. If hired you will confirm on the Pre-Season Planner your commitment for the weekends in May. This significantly helps reduce questions about that time period.

All Funland employees complete a Duration of Work Agreement when hired. This form is where you indicate your work commitment to Funland during the summer. You indicate any time-off you plan to take over the summer as well as your full time start and end dates. Your ability to follow through on the commitment you make to Funland is so important to us it determines if you can receive the seasonal bonus.

Before making your decision to work for Funland, be advised that most of your time as well as your best effort will be expected. Funland continues to get busier each summer, and we need as much help as possible from the moment we open until the last day of the season. While Funland will remain as flexible as possible with time off, Funland is a seasonal business, and we must keep a full staff to operate safely and efficiently throughout the entire season.
