


PARKING RULES


When arriving for work please look for available parking in the Royal Treat Parking Lot on Delaware Avenue. Fill one of 18 parking spaces facing the Beach View Motel if they are available. If those 18 spots are full please use one of the spots along the wall of the building next to us. Approximately 10 cars should fit along the wall parallel to the building. If all of those parking spaces are full start filling the spots in the office driveway. Please enter and exit all parking areas slowly as the sidewalks are often very busy.

When parking in the office driveway please start with the left side pulling all the way up to the dumpster. Once the left side is full start filling the right side pulling up to the orange cone or close to the stairs of the apartment. When parking in the driveway make sure to pull up as close as possible to the vehicle in front of you. This allows us to get more vehicles in the driveway.



If you are parking in the office driveway near the sidewalk you need to make sure that your vehicle does not hang over the sidewalk. We cannot block the sidewalk for any reason and if you do the city will ticket your vehicle. Vehicles either need to be all the way in the driveway or in one of the three street spots. Funland is not responsible for any parking violations issued by the City of Rehoboth Beach.



If both the Royal Treat lot and the office driveway are full you can park in one of the three additional street spots in front of the office driveway. The first two cars that park in the street should park on either side as close to the yellow line as possible without going over. (See picture below)



If you park on the yellow line you could be ticketed by the city and if you don't park close enough to the yellow line we cannot get a third vehicle in the middle of that area. Funland is not responsible for any parking violations issued by the City of Rehoboth Beach.

If all of the parking spots in the Royal Treat Lot and the office driveway are full please stay in your vehicle and call the office at 302-227-2785 or call/text the Manager of Duty phone 302-604-2595. We have a few other options that we can use if all standard parking is full.

When entering or exiting any of our parking areas please use extreme caution. The sidewalks are generally very busy and kids often run ahead of their parents excited by the sounds of FUNLAND.

When you park in a Funland lot, you **MUST** have a parking permit displayed. If you do not have a parking permit displayed in your windshield it makes enforcement of our parking lots more difficult. This can also be an issue if we need to move vehicles. If you notice a vehicle that does not have a Funland parking permit please inform the office staff so it can be investigated. If you are driving a different vehicle and forgot to move your parking permit over, please inform the office staff so that we can provide you a temporary permit.



Regardless of where you park your vehicle, it is mandatory that you hang your keys in the office on the hook that corresponds to your parking permit number. Do not get into the habit of putting your keys in your locker or personal bag.

PLEASE NOTE THAT FUNLAND NEEDS TO MOVE VEHICLES AT THE END OF THE NIGHT AS WELL AS FOR DIFFERENT REASONS THROUGHOUT THE DAY. IF AN EMPLOYEE VEHICLE NEEDS TO BE MOVED ONLY FAMILY MEMBERS OR SUPERVISOR WILL DO SO. YOU ARE NOT TO MOVE ANOTHER EMPLOYEE'S VEHICLE FOR ANY REASON. PLEASE NOTE THAT IF YOU ARE NOT COMFORTABLE WITH A FAMILY MEMBER/ SUPERVISOR MOVING YOUR VEHICLE YOUR ALTERNATIVE IS TO BUY A PARKING PERMIT AND PARK IN A RESIDENTIAL AREA, TAKE THE PARK 'N RIDE OR GET DROPPED OFF.

If you lose your parking pass please notify the office. There is a \$10.00 replacement fee.

All parking permits must be returned at the end of your Funland employment.

Parking at Funland is only to be used when you are scheduled to work. If you are scheduled to work at 5pm do not plan on parking and going to the beach starting at 10am! You are allowed to use the parking lot up to an hour before the start of your shift.

At the end of each night it is important to remove your vehicle from our parking area. Once you sign out you should move your vehicle. If you want to go out with friends, get something to eat, etc it should be done after your vehicle is moved. The city stops patrolling for parking enforcement at 10pm and street parking is available after that time. At no time should a vehicle be left in one of the parking areas overnight.

If at any time we have too many drivers and not enough parking we will ask people to carpool or parking will be reassigned by seniority.

PARKING AT FUNLAND IS A PRIVILEGE THAT CAN BE REVOKED FOR ANY REASON AT ANY TIME.

FUNLAND IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY THEFT OR DAMAGE DONE TO YOUR VEHICLE WHILE ON PROPERTY.
