We want you to know that when you work with our family you are not just another employee but part of our family. Several generations of Funland family members are actively involved in the daily operation of the park so we get to know our employees on a personal level since we work side by side all summer! Many employers are only interested in how many hours you will work or how many shifts your can cover but we want this to be a well rounded experience where you also make friends, grow and create lasting memories.

Throughout the summer our family offers opportunities to interact with your co-workers outside of work. We offer pizza every week after our employee meetings, multiple games tournaments throughout the summer, a movie night, Skeeball/bumper car nights, Employee BBQ, employee breakfast, Employee Appreciation Day, Labor Day Raffle and more. At the end of the summer we hope that you not only worked hard and made great money but that your time at Funland was more than just a job.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Game Attendant*

- Operate our 16 amusement games
- Operate the Jungle of Fun, Food Cart, Haunted Mansion Photo Stand and more
- Work with children and the public every day
- Give out prizes to customers that win one of our games and share the excitement with them!
- Work in a fun atmosphere on the boardwalk all summer making memories to last a lifetime

As a Game Attendant at Funland, your primary responsibility will be to operate our 16 amusement games and the Jungle of Fun, ensuring a safe and efficient experience for guests. You'll rotate daily among different games, giving you variety in your work and the chance to get to know our entire team of employees. Teamwork is the foundation of our success and is essential to being a valued Funland employee.

Responsibilities as a Game Attendant:

- Operate each assigned game efficiently and effectively to create an enjoyable experience for guests.
- You'll be provided with a game bag with money at the start of each shift. You are responsible for this money plus any money collected during your shift.
- Celebrate with guest's when they win by awarding them the appropriate stuffed animal or prize.
- Must be willing to smile and engage customers.
- Maintain speed and efficiency to ensure that as many guests as possible can enjoy each game.
- We offer a variety of games, including individual skill games, group competitions, and chance-based games, providing a well-rounded work experience.

While 90% of your role will be operating games, we also have other areas you may work if you show interest and demonstrate reliability. These include the food cart, Haunted Mansion photo stand, Funland Store, and ticket booth. If you perform well as a Game Attendant, we'll do our best to offer you opportunities to work in these areas.

^{*} Employment at Funland is at-will. An at-will employment relationship can be terminated at any time, with or without reason or notice by either the employer or the employee.

- End of season performance bonus worth up to \$1.00 for every hour worked during the summer in addition to your \$16.00 per hour.

- Funland offers weekly direct deposit pay.
- Payday is every Friday after 5pm.

BASE WAGE

As a Funland Game Attendant you will be paid \$15.00 per hour. Funland, as a seasonal business is exempt from overtime but as a 14/15 year old employee you are not allowed to work over 40 hours a week. Most game attendants work 4/5 days a week and 25-35 hours per week.

\$1.00 END OF SEASON BONUS

Funland also offers an end of season performance based bonus. You can earn up to an additional \$1.00 for every hour worked during the summer. With many game attendants working 250-350 hours during the summer it would be equivalent to approximately one additional paycheck! Your end of season bonus is tied to the Duration of Work Agreement form* and completing at least 100 hours of emloyment. If you stay for the time you commit to on that form, you are eligible for the bonus. You are then evaluated on your performance to determine your bonus number. Last summer the average bonus was \$.87 out of \$1.00!

*The end of season bonus program is voluntary and is in no way an employment contract. Funland offers at-will employment only.

Funland is proud to offer competitive pay and consistent hours. Most employees find they can work the hours they want at Funland without having to seek additional hours elsewhere.

Summer 2026 Hours & Shifts Game Attendant

- You never work before 10am or after 7pm.
 (Except June 1st-Labor Day there is a 9pm end time)
- Funland will work with each employee to determine the best number of days/hours to work each week.
- Funland offers two main shifts and you alternate between starting at 10am or 1pm.
- As a 14/15 year old employee, you have specific limitations while working which are listed on the work permit you must complete.

As a Funland Game Attendant we will work with you to determine the proper work life balance. Once we determine how many hours each week you are looking to work we base your schedule on that information. There are two main shifts that game attendants are scheduled. The first shift is 10am-5pm (shift A) and the second is 1pm-7pm (shift B). Each has a half hour break for either lunch or dinner and employees are scheduled a mix of both shifts. Most game attendants take at least two days off each week and if possible we like to set them for the entire summer.

SHIFT A 10pm-5pm (30 min lunch break) SHIFT B 1pm-7pm (30 minute dinner break)



Using the example work schedule above, someone would work 29.5 hours in a week. It is common for the game attendant position to be filled by someone who has never had a job before. We want all of our employees to enjoy their job, so we take extra care to make your first work experience a positive one. If for some reason you are overwhelmed by the hours, we are willing to work with you. It is sometimes hard to find the right balance at first, so we encourage new employees to say something if needed.

HOURS & SHIFTS

Below we have listed all of the possible shifts that you might be scheduled in the park. As you can see, there are lots of opportunities to mix and match shifts to get the perfect number of hours.

Below are all the restrictions 14/15 years old employees must follow

Minors 14-15 years of age shall not work:

- Before 7am or after 7pm except from June 1st through Labor Day when it is extended until 9pm.
- More than 4 hours per day on a school day
- More than 8 hours per day on non school days
- More than 18 hours in any week when school is in session for 5 days
- More than 6 days in any week

5pm-9pm

- More than 40 hours per week when school is not in session
- More than 5 hours continuously without a non-work period of at least 30 minutes

As a Funland employee we expect three main things from our employees.

SAFETY - COURTESY - HUSTLE

Safety is our most important responsibility and is the most important part of your job. Our customers come to the park to have fun and smile but it is our responsibility to keep them safe while in the park. Our employees must also be happy, helpful and ready to go above and beyond for the children and adults visiting the park. If you like to smile and watch children smile, Funland is the place for you! We are very busy at Funland, so it is important to be able to work in a fast paced environment and an outdoor environment. We want to accommodate the needs of as many customers as possible and our employees are the key. If you are ready to work hard, smile, make great friends then you should consider working with our family.

2026 CALENDAR

- Funland opens for the 2026 season on Saturday, May 9th 2026. (Mother's Day weekend)
- Funland will only be open weekends until Friday, May 29th, 2026 when the park opens daily.
- Funland's last day for the 2026 season will be Sunday, September 13th, 2026.

Funland operates for three weekends before opening full-time in early June. We consider the first two weekends training weekends and employees are expected to attend at least one of these weekends for orientation and hands-on training. Attendance during the third weekend, Memorial Day Weekend, is mandatory, as it's our busiest weekend of the season. If hired, you will confirm your availability for these weekends on the Pre-Season Planner form*, which helps us manage scheduling and ensures we have adequate coverage.

All employees complete a Duration of Work Agreement* to outline their full-time start date (typically 4-5 days per week), any planned vacations or scheduled time off, and their intended last day of work for the season. This form is critical for our seasonal planning and is also tied to eligibility for the end-of-season bonus.

At Funland, we aim to create a fun, rewarding experience for both employees and guests. As a seasonal business, we experience high demand from opening day to the end of the summer, so your commitment and best effort are essential. While we strive to accommodate time-off requests, maintaining a full, reliable staff is crucial for keeping the park safe and enjoyable for our guests throughout the season.

Note: *Completion of the Pre-Season Planner and Duration of Work Agreement forms does not constitute an employment contract. These forms allow Funland to coordinate scheduling based on availability. Funland maintains an at-will employment relationship, meaning employment can be terminated at any time, by either the employer or the employee, with or without notice or reason.
